SUBJECT: V-1522 - REQUEST TO VACATE PLATTED "COMPLETE ACCESS CONTROL", LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF SENECA, IN AN AREA SOUTH OF PAWNEE. (District #4)

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of access control.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of access control. (unanimous)

Background: This vacation has been requested in order to improve traffic flow into and out of the subject site. The Vacation Order retains access control except for one opening. The Traffic Engineer and the City Engineer's Office are in support of this vacation case. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described access control, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. "Access control except for one (1) opening" is hereby retained.
6. The vacation of the access control described herein should be approved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE CITY COUNCIL, on this 29th day of March, 1988, ordered that the above-described access control is hereby vacated. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk shall certify a copy of this order to the Register of Deeds of Sedgwick County.
