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Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.

Background: This vacation is requested to allow construction of a house across a common lot line where one of the lots has a 80-foot building setback because of being a flag shaped lot. A restrictive covenant that requires that the two lots not be sold separately has been submitted. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order, and restrictive covenant, recording costs to be billed to:

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. The vacation of the building setback described herein should be approved.
