Background: The applicant's retention wall currently encroaches into the utility easement seven feet. He also wishes to construct a swimming pool. The utility companies have indicated their approval as there are no utilities in this easement. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

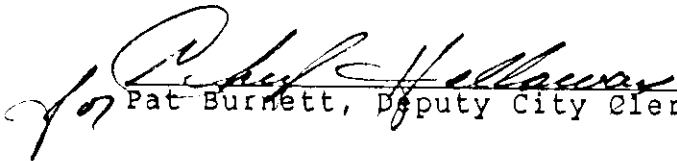

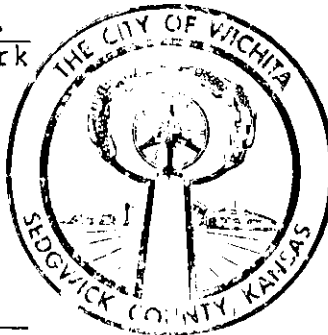

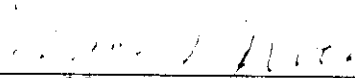
