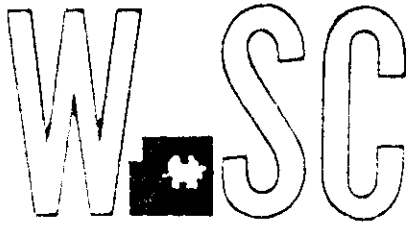

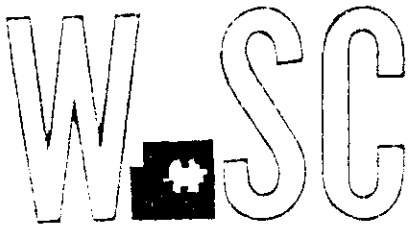

LEGAL DESCRIPTION: The access control as platted to Seneca, across the east lot line of Lot 1, Adamson Addition, Wichita, KS

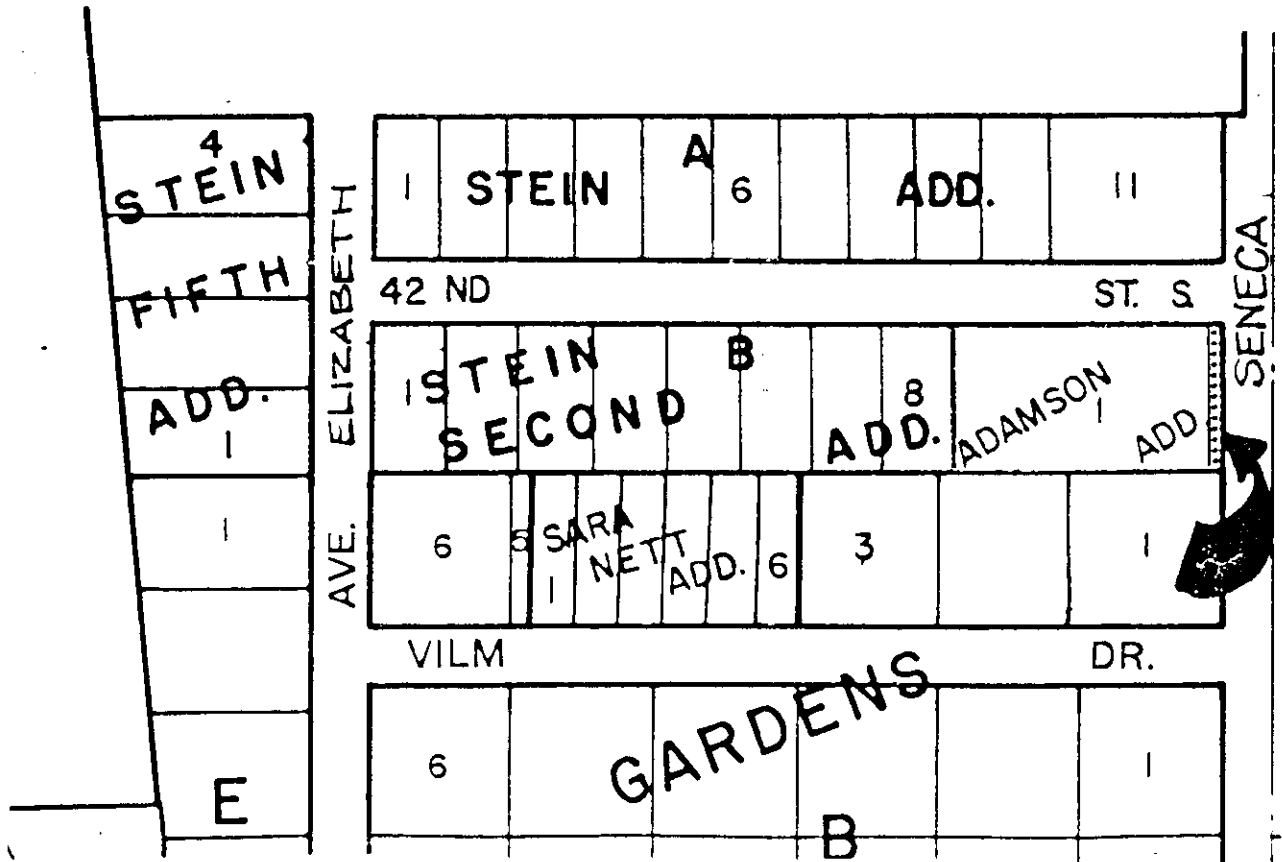
LOCATION: West side of Seneca in an area south of 42nd Street South
