SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING V-1767 REQUEST TO VACATE A UTILITY EASEMENT
LOCATED SOUTH OF 19TH STREET NORTH AND EAST OF TYLER ROAD
(District #5)

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.
(unanimous)

Background: Additional area in the property's rear yard is needed for a planned swimming pool. Sanitary sewer is in the easement, but only in the eastern section being excluded from the vacation. Both City Engineering and the utility representatives of the Subdivision and Utility Advisory Committee indicate the other portion of the easement is not needed.

The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve the vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of the Vacation Order; recording costs to be billed to:

NOW on this 16th day of June, 1992, comes on for hearing the petition for vacation filed by Douglas E. Cary and Russell A. Johnston, praying for the vacation of the following described utility easement, to-wit:

The 20-foot utility easement as platted adjacent to the south line of Lot 1, Block 1, of the Donald Cary Addition, Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas. Except the east 30-foot thereof.

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Reporter of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on 6-2-92 & 6-9-92.

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described utility easement, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.

3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

5. The vacation of the utility easement described herein should be approved.

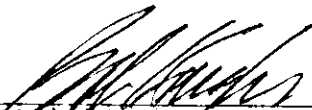

EASEMENT

THIS EASEMENT made this 22 day of April, 1981
by and between P.M.A., Inc.
of the first part and City of Wichita, Kansas
of the second part.

WITNESSETH: that the said first party, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey unto the said second parties a perpetual right of way and easement for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and repairing their Sanitary Sewer, over, along under the following described real estate situated in Sedgwick County, Kansas, to wit:

The following is a description of a Sanitary Sewer Easement located in the southeast quarter of Section 8, Township 27 south, Range 2 east of the 6th P.M., Sedgwick County, Kansas, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Section 8, Township 27 south, Range 2 east of the 6th P.M., Sedgwick County, Kansas; thence N 00° 00' 00" E, along the east boundary line of said Section 8, 1452.56 feet; thence leaving said east boundary line of Section 8, N 90° 00' 00" W, 87.08 feet to a point on the west edge of a 33 foot Cities Service Gas Company Easement, also being the point of beginning; thence along said west edge of the Cities Service Gas Company Easement S 0° 11' 39" W, 1392.60 feet; thence S 89° 58' 50" W, parallel to the south boundary of the southeast quarter of Section 8, Township 27 south, Range 2 east of the 6th P.M., 1243.63 feet to a point on the east boundary of Country Places Estates, an addition to Sedgwick County, Kansas; thence along said east boundary N 0° 06' 10" E, 120 feet; thence S 89° 53' 50" E, 20 feet; thence S 0° 06' 10" W, 94.96 feet; thence N 89° 58' 50" E, 1221.67 feet; thence N 0° 11' 39" E, 330.03 feet; thence N 90° 00' 00" W, 10.00 feet; thence N 0° 11' 39" E, 50.00 feet; thence N 90° 00' 00" E, 10.00 feet; thence N 0° 11' 39" E, 987.57 feet; thence N 90° 00' 00" E, 2.00 feet to the point of beginning.

And said second party are hereby granted the right to enter upon said premises at any time for the purpose of constructing, operating, maintaining, and repairing their Sanitary Sewer, including the right to open and excavate in any streets or ways that may be constructed on the surface of said easements, provided that upon completion of the necessities of grantee's operations the surface of such easements shall be restored as nearly as possible to its original condition.

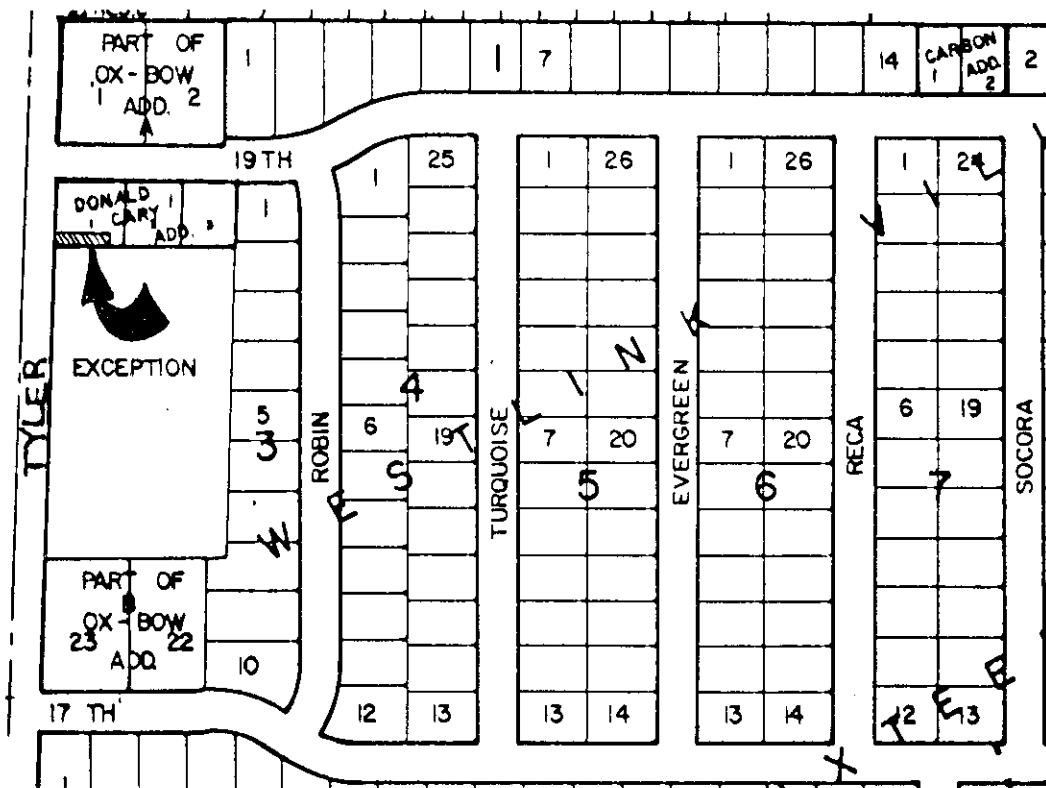
