Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of easement. (unanimous)

Background: In order to provide for the expansion of an existing structure the applicant has relocated a sanitary sewer line from the area of easement being vacated. This relocation has been approved by City Engineering and the utility advisory subcommittee has indicated they have no objections to the vacation. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order, recording costs to be billed to:

VACATION ORDER

NOW on this 15th day of October, 1991, comes on for hearing the petition for vacation filed by J. Larry Fugate, praying for the vacation of the following described easement, to-wit:

A 20 foot easement lying 10 feet on either side of a line described as follows: Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 5, Farmington Square 2nd Addition, Wichita, Kansas; thence S04°33'32"E, along the east line of said Lot 1, 37.79 feet to a point of beginning; thence S89°59'27"W, parallel to the north line of said Lot 1, 10 feet. Said easement was previously granted at Film 773, Page 277.

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Reporter of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on 10/2/91 & 10/9/91.

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described easement, and the public will suffer **no loss or inconvenience** thereby.

3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

5. The vacation of the easement described herein should be approved.

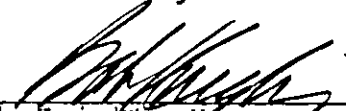
