SUBJECT: V- 1818; Request to vacate building setback, generally located south of Kellogg and east of 143rd Street East.

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department



AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation (unanimous).

Background: This is the vacation of a portion of a platted building setback. Mr. & Mrs. Bays intend to construct their single-family home on this lot, and prefer that the structure be oriented towards a nearby lake. In order to accomplish this, the vacation of a 15-foot portion of the 40-foot [front yard] building setback is required, which will increase the amount of buildable space for the house. The vacated building setback will only apply to that portion that is immediately adjacent to the house. Staff and MAPC have recommended approval because 25 feet of building setback will continue to be available adjacent to and in front of the house, 40 feet of building setback will continue to be available for the remainder of the front yard, and the vacation will not adversely affect the public interest.

Because this site is located in an unincorporated area of the county, but within three-miles of the City of Wichita, and pending Council approval, this vacation will be scheduled for final public hearing by the Board of County Commissioners.

This vacation has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions and recording within 30 days.

RECOMMENDATIONS/ACTIONS: Approve the vacation.

WHEREUPON, it is shown that proper notice has been given by publication once each week for three consecutive weeks in the official county newspaper, the first such publication having occurred on July 23, 1993; and it is further shown that proper proof of such publication has been filed herein. The Board finds that such notice is in lawful form and that it conforms to K.S.A. 58-2613.

THEREAFTER, the Board, having heard all interested parties and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, finds and determines that no private rights will be injured or endangered by such vacation; that the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby; that no written objections hereto have been filed with the Sedgwick County Clerk; and that, in justice to the petitioner, the petition's prayer should be granted.
