



Background: Applicant requests the vacation of six (6) feet of access control to increase the current access control opening. The stated vacation would pose no harm to this or adjacent properties, as stated and recommended for approval by Traffic Engineering, City Engineering and the utility companies.

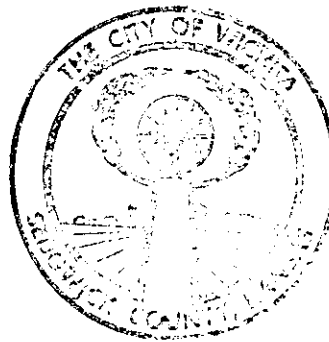
