Background: The applicant desires to vacate an alley in order to better utilize the property for development purposes. The alley right-of-way will be retained as a utility easement and the applicant provided a covenant, as requested by the MAPC, that will allow access across the vacated alley to the adjacent land owners to the south of the applicant's site. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

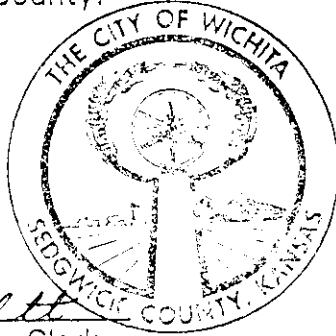

6. The vacation of the an alley described herein should be approved.



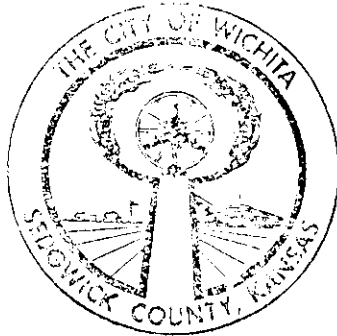


