**Staff Recommendation:** Approve vacation of a portion of 25 foot building setback.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of a portion of 25 foot building setback.  
(unanimous)

Background: The applicant is requesting to vacate a slight portion of the platted 25 foot building setback. The setback is along the north and is platted from Ironwood Court. The vacation would allow the applicant to add a third bay to the existing two-car garage.

Public Works has reviewed and approved this request. The Subdivision Committee and the MAPC both voted unanimously to approve the requested vacation of a portion of the building setback.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Actions: Close the public hearing, approve the vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record the certified copy of the Vacation Order.

Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Lot 12, Block 3, Willowbend 1st Addition to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas; thence S 89° 10' 51" W, 33 feet along the North line of said Lot 12; thence S 0° 49' 09" E, 23.74 feet parallel to the East line of said Lot 12 to the point of beginning; thence continuing S 0° 49' 09" E, 1.26 feet; thence S 89° 10' 51" W, 200.00 feet parallel to the North line of said Lot 12; thence N 0° 49' 09" W, 1.26 feet parallel to the East line of said Lot 12; thence N 89° 10' 51" E, 20.00 feet parallel to the North line of said Lot 12 to the point of beginning.

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Reporter of notice of this one time 9-22-98, which was at least 20 days prior to this public hearing.
2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described 25 foot building setback, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
