(District #2)

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve the vacation of a portion of a building setback.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve the vacation of a portion of a building setback. (unanimous)

Background: The applicant is requesting to vacate a portion of the platted 35 foot building setback. The setback is along the north line of Lot 2, Block 1, Northrock Crossing and would reduce the building setback to 26.75 feet. The vacation would allow the expansion of the existing building.

Public Works has reviewed and approved the vacation request. The Subdivision Committee and the MAPC both voted unanimously to approve the requested vacation of a portion of the building setback.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Actions: Close the public hearing, approve the vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record the certified copy of the Vacation Order.

A reduction of the building setback along the north line of Lot 2, Block 1, Northrock Crossing Addition to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas from 35 feet to 26.75 feet for the east 202 feet of the west 275 feet of said Lot 2.

3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
