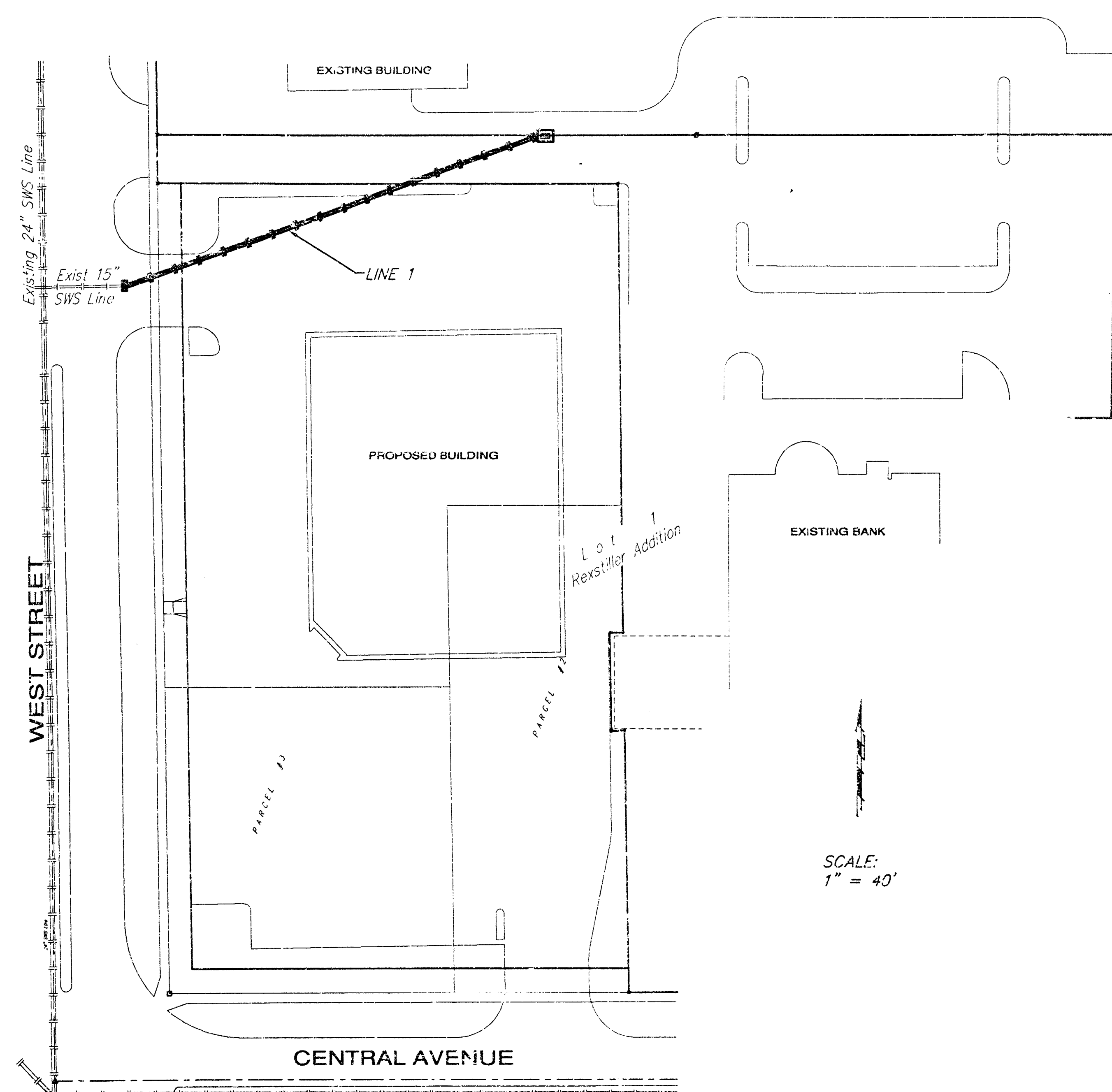

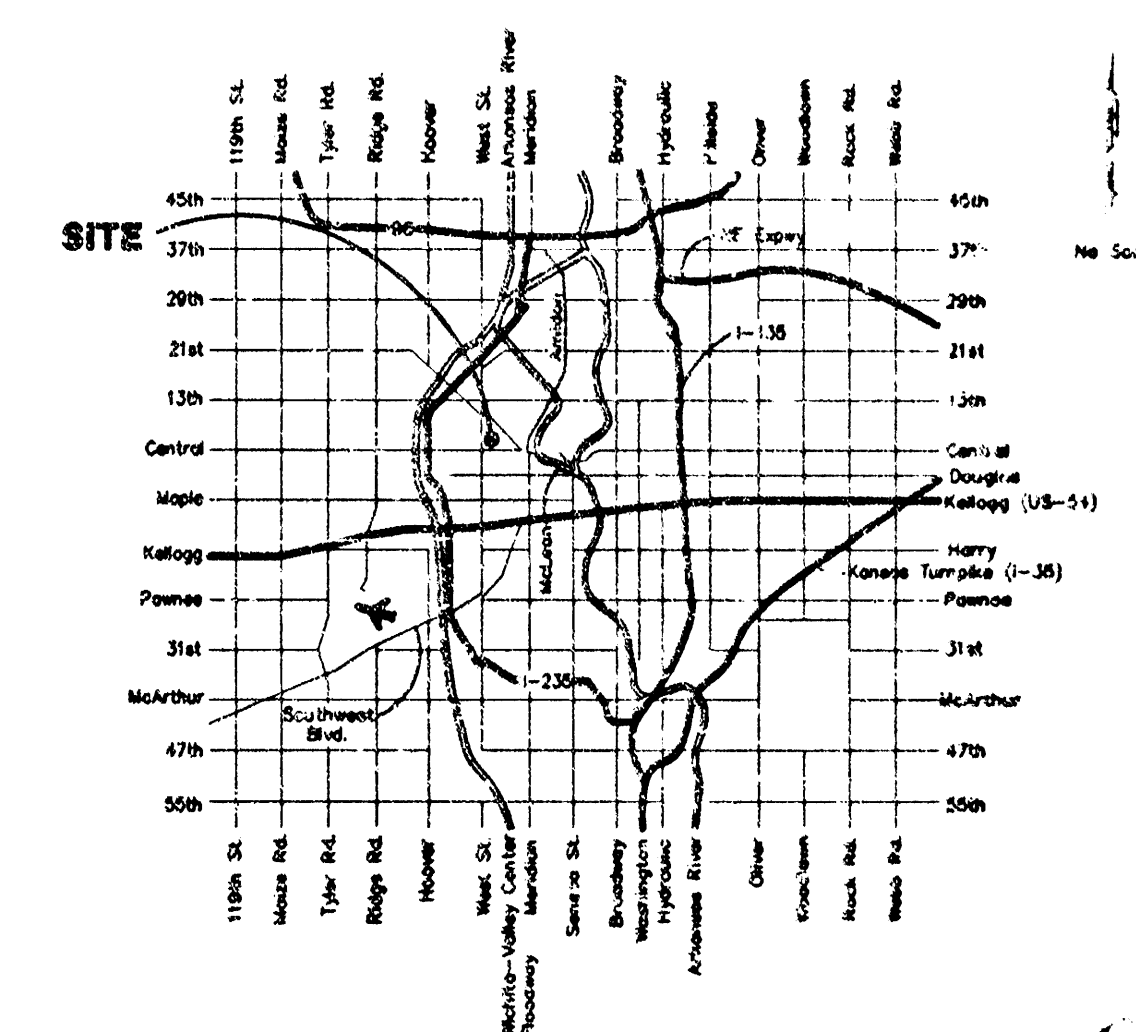
LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

That part of Lot 1, Rexstiller Addition to Wichita, Kansas, described as follows: thence N00°44'00"W along the west line of Lot 1 in said Rexstiller Addition, 332.00 feet to a point 20.00 feet south of the SW corner of Lot 1, NW Building Addition, Wichita, Kansas; thence N90°00'00"E parallel with the south line of Lot 1 in said Rexstiller Addition, 200.00 feet; thence S00°44'00"E parallel with the west line of Lot 1 in said Rexstiller Addition, 185.00 feet; thence S89°16'00"W perpendicular to the last described course, 6.00 feet; thence S00°44'00"E parallel with the west line of Lot 1 in said Rexstiller Addition, 40.00 feet; thence N89°16'00"E perpendicular to the last described corner, 6.00 feet; thence S00°44'00"E parallel with the west line of Lot 1 in said Rexstiller Addition, 107.00 feet to a point on the south line of Lot 1 in said Rexstiller Addition; thence N90°00'00"W along the south line of Lot 1 in said Rexstiller Addition, 200.00 feet to the point of beginning.

Square cut on top of retaining wall 50.0' North and 50.0' West of the centerline of both Central Ave. and West Street.

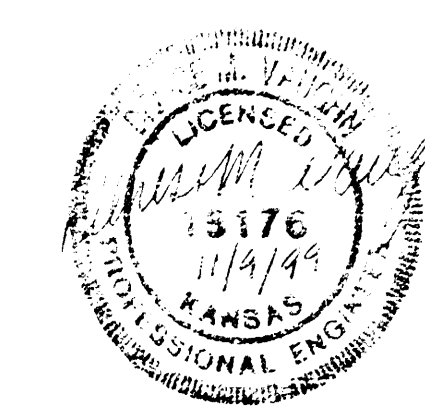
- Contractor will be required to provide notice to utility companies a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours prior to any excavation, as follows:

- Underground utility service lines and overhead utility pole lines are to be adjusted as necessary by others prior to construction unless the plans specifically call for their adjustment by the Contractor or unless the plans specifically identify a utility to be adjusted by its owner during construction. Existing utilities and their location, as shown on the plans, represent the best information obtainable for design. The Contractor will be required to work around existing utilities within the right-of-way which do not conflict with proposed construction.
- Contractor shall not start work on the project until the Project Inspector is assigned to the project and is present on the site. Any work done without inspection will be required to be uncovered for inspection.
- Trees and shrubs in public right-of-way which are in direct conflict with proposed new construction shall be removed by the Contractor with the Engineer's approval. Trees and shrubs which are not in direct conflict with proposed new construction shall be saved and protected from damage.
- Rubble from the removal of miscellaneous structures and excess excavation which is to be wasted shall be disposed of on sites to be provided by the Contractor. These sites shall be approved by the Engineer as to suitability, appearance and site location. Locations that, in the opinion of the Engineer, will leave an unsightly appearance will not be approved. All disposal sites must be approved by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment. Material either stockpiled or disposed of in a flood plain would require a Kansas State Board of Agriculture permit. Any material dumped in waters of the United States or wetlands is subject to U.S. Corps. of Engineers permitting regulations. Any material buried or stockpiled beyond approved construction limits would require additional archaeological investigations unless buried in a previously approved borrow location.

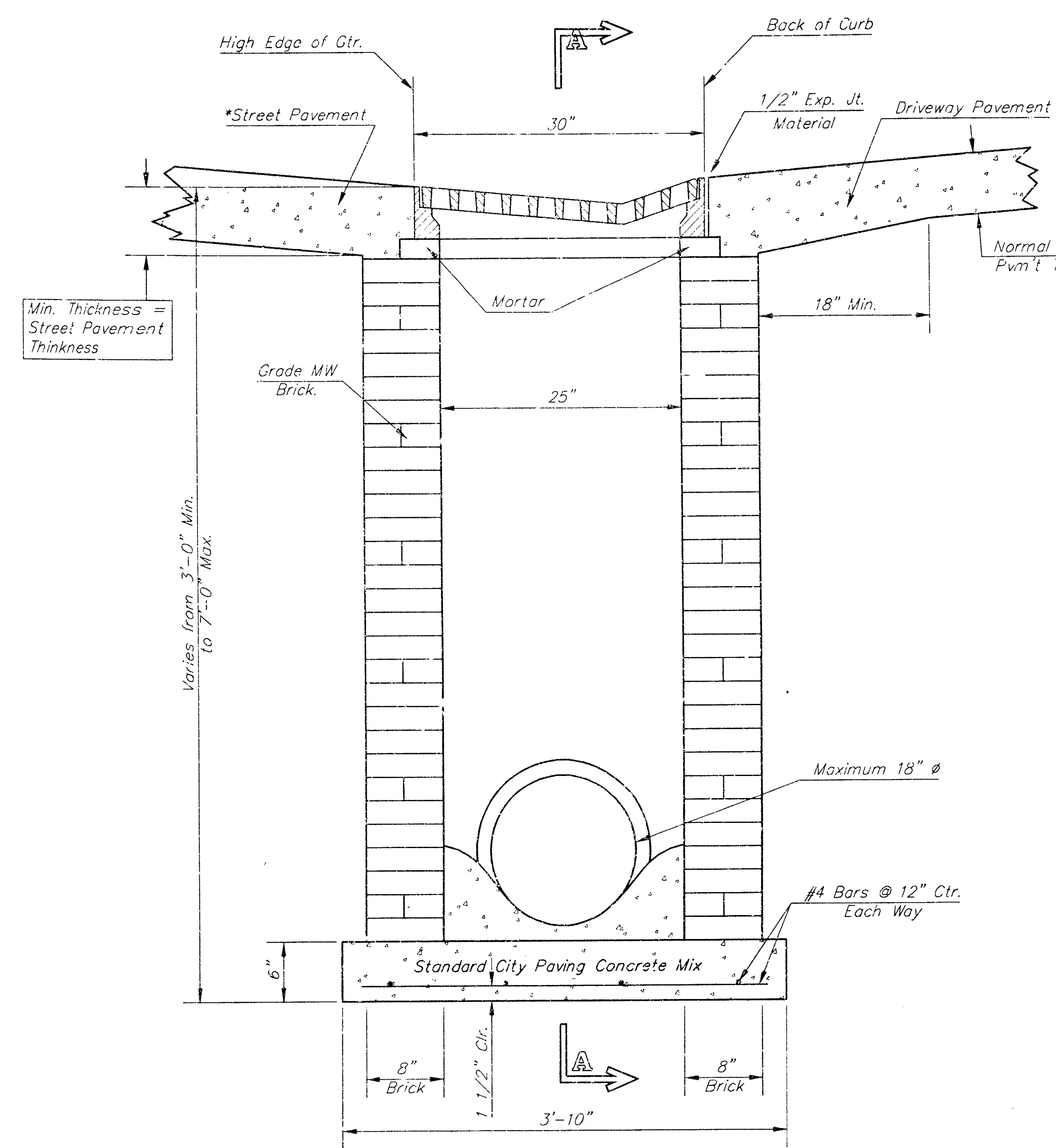

NOTE TO CONTRACTORS

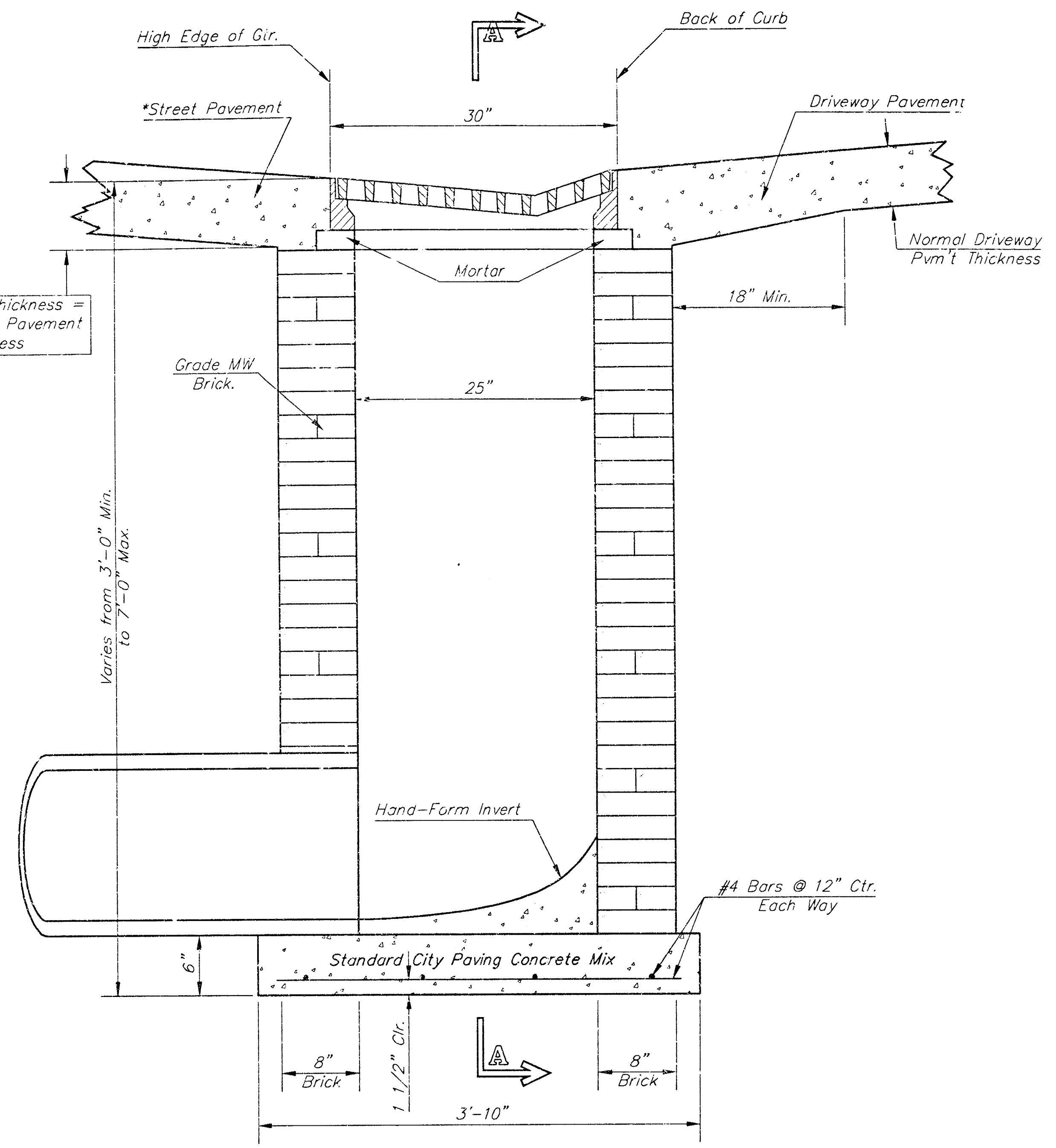

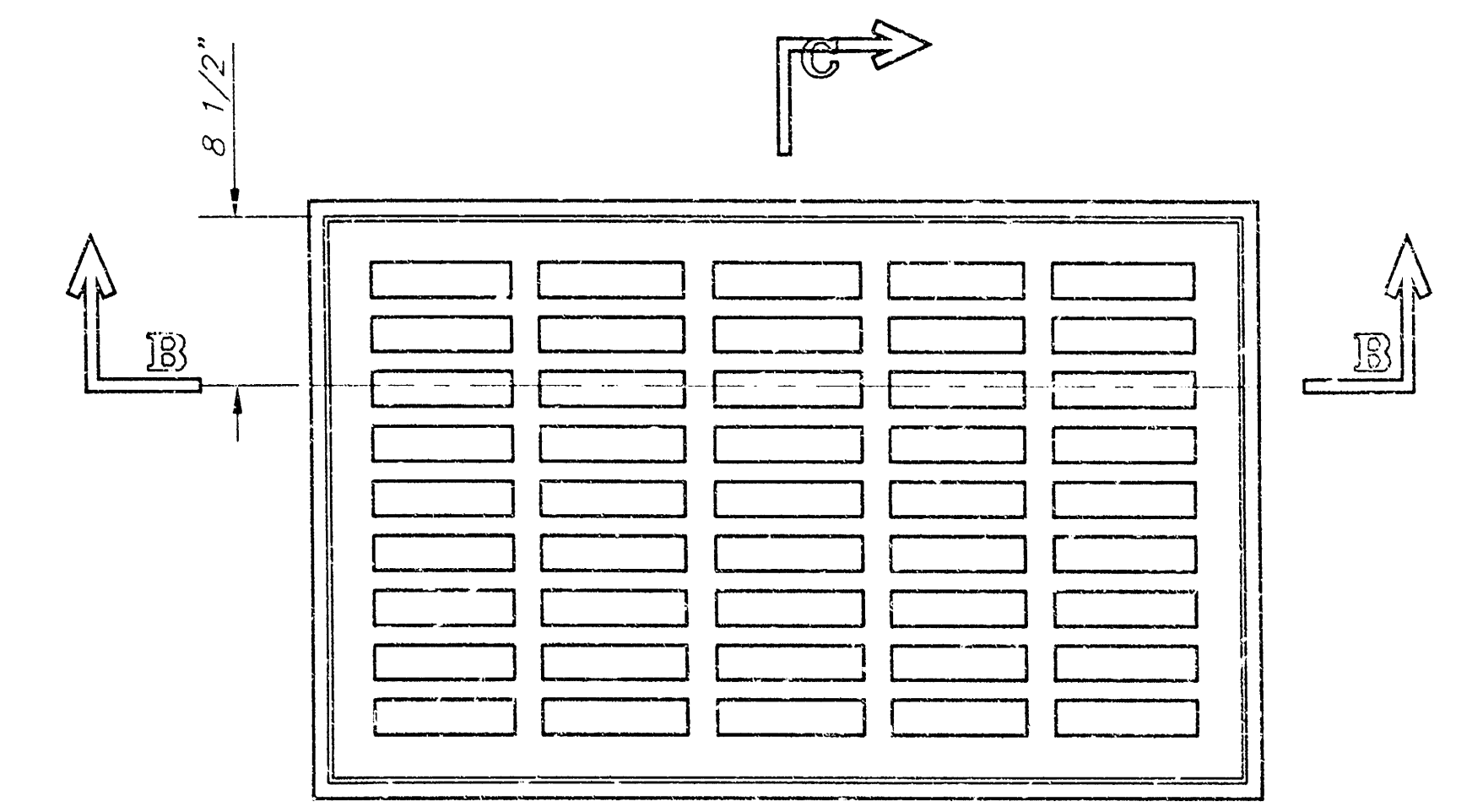
SIDE OUTLET



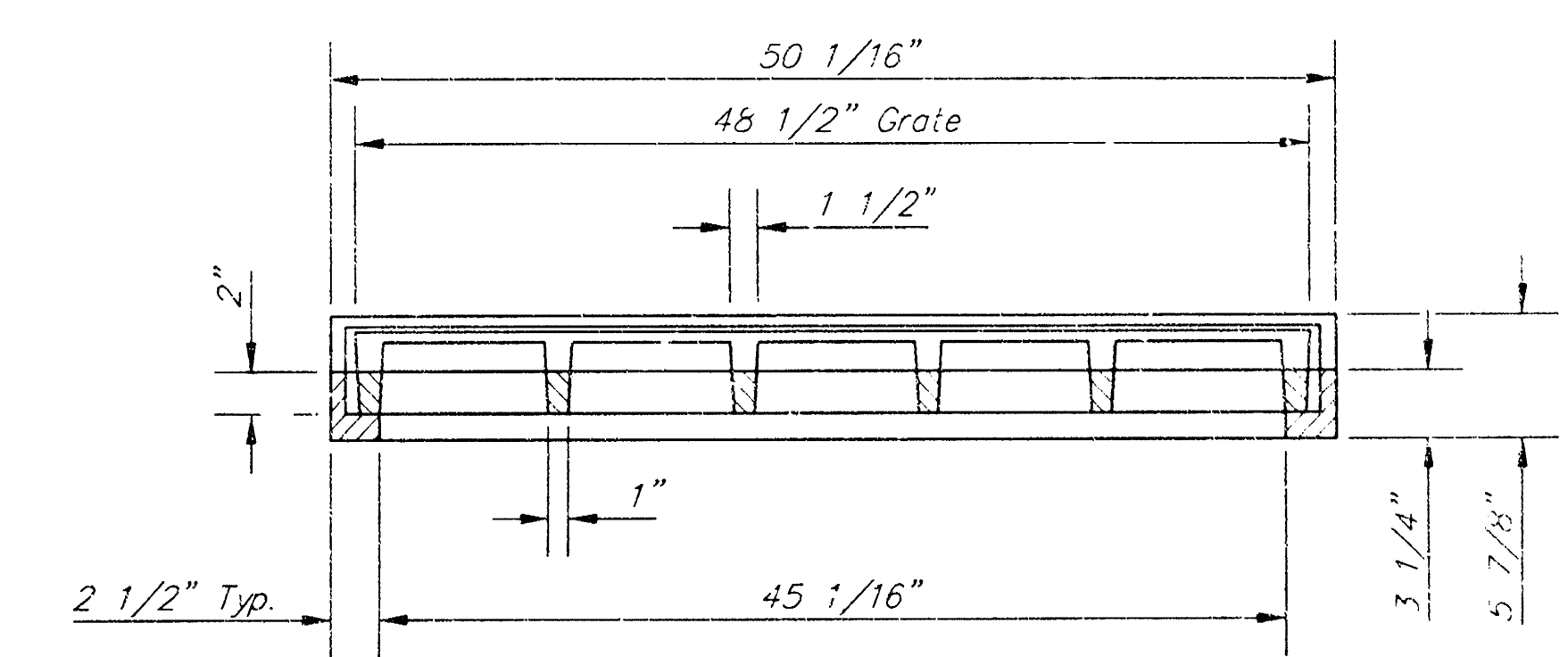

GENERAL NOTES

1. Grate frame to be installed on thin mortar cushion to insure full support along brick walls. Concrete used for inlet construction shall be concrete pavement mix.
2. Inlet invert shall be shaped with 8 sack sand mix concrete to create flow channels and to increase hydraulic efficiency such that the inlet will be self cleaning between all inlet and/or outlet pipes.
3. The ends of all pipes installed in inlets shall be cut off flush with the inside face of the inlet wall.
4. Inlet Frame and Grate to be Deeter #2095 or approved equal.

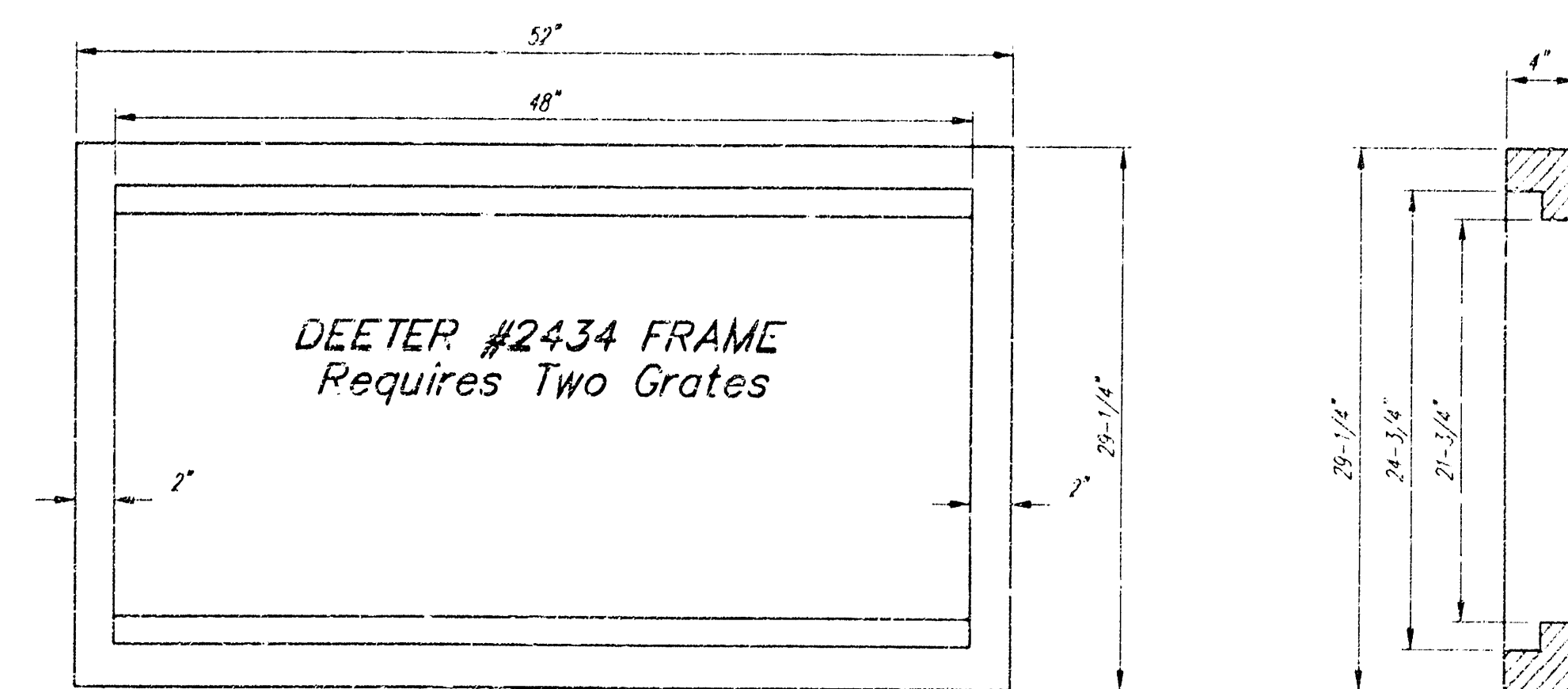

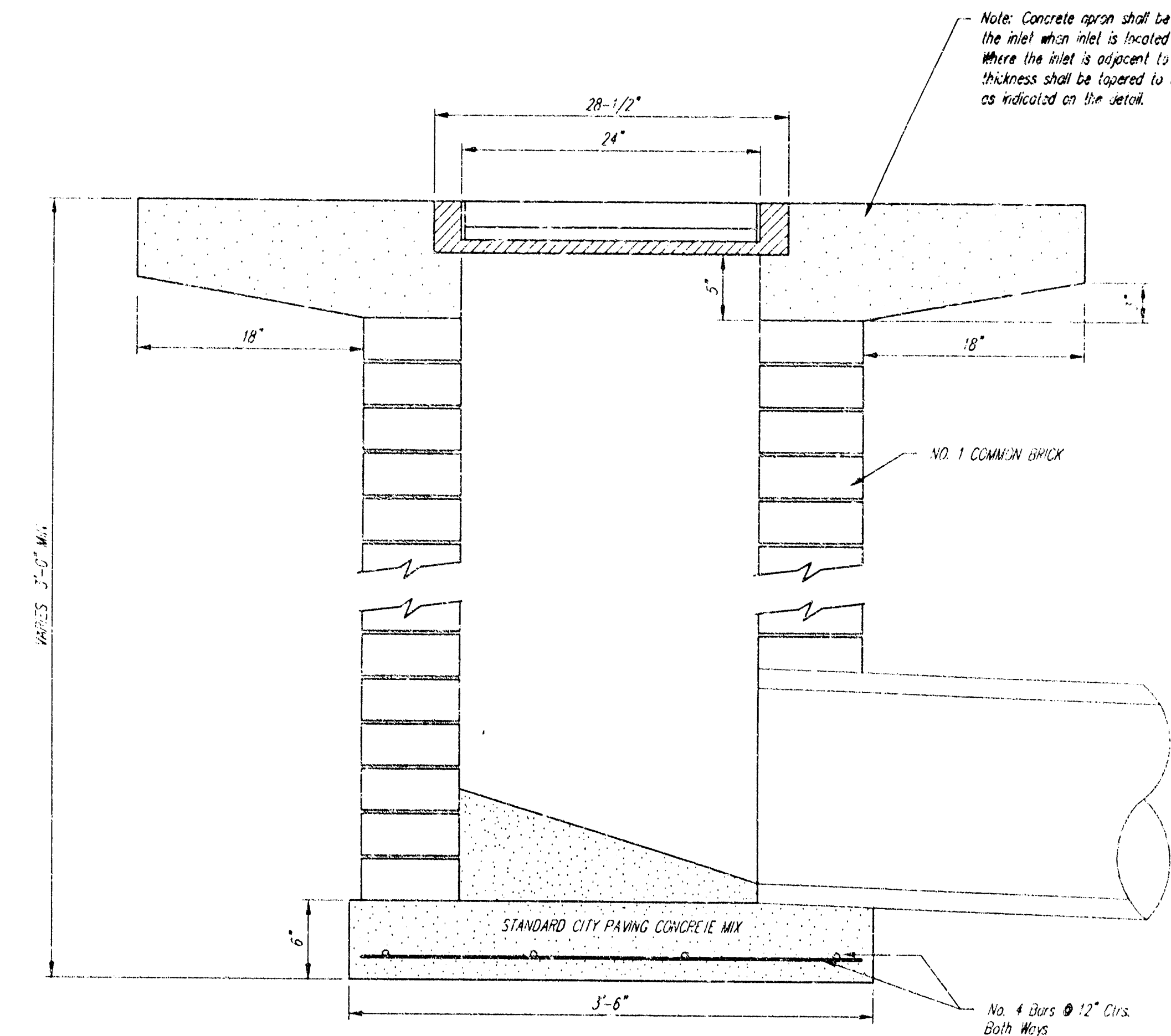
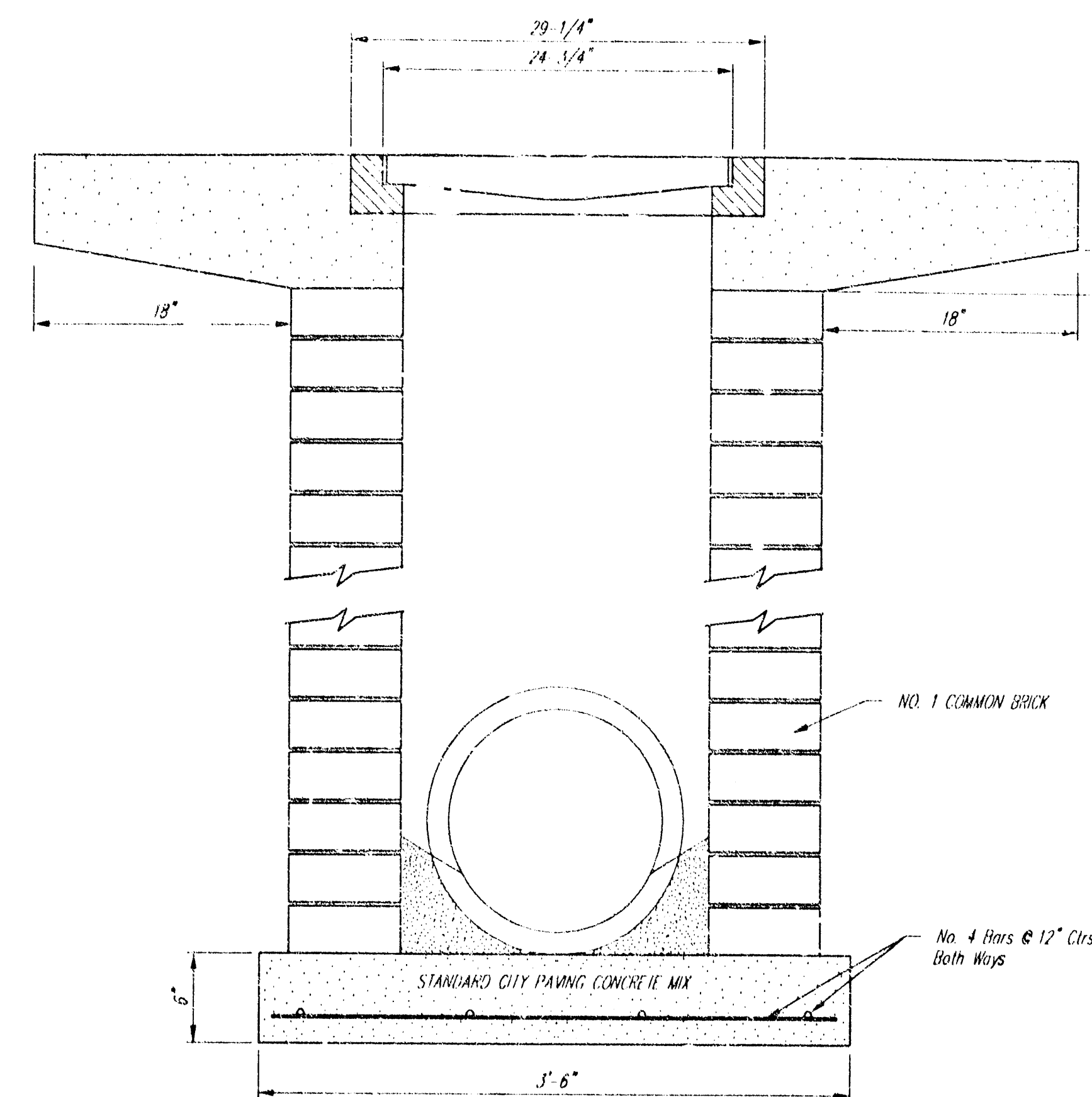
DEETER #2433 GRATE

24" x 24" Frame and Grate Detail

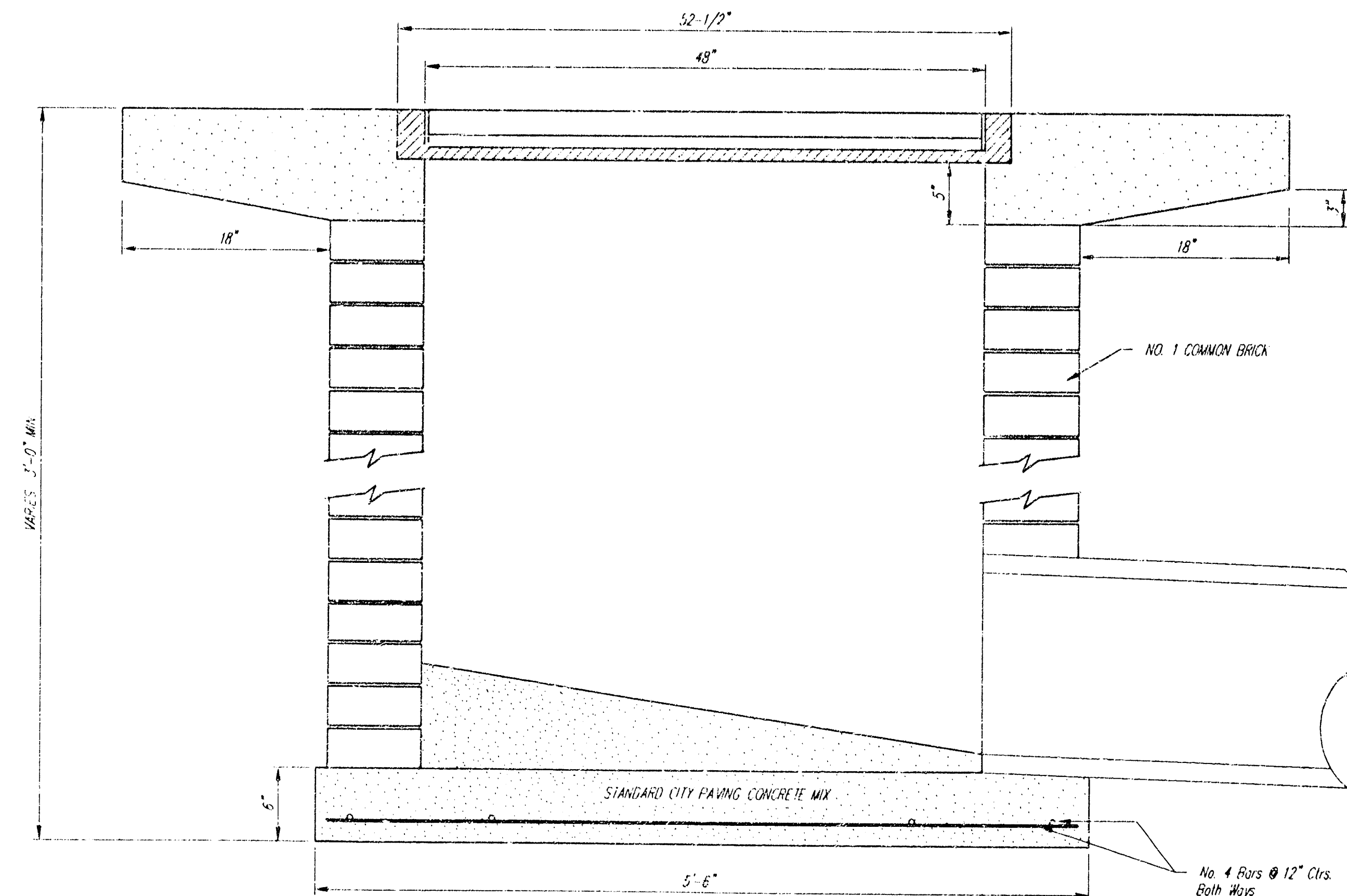


Double 24" x 24" Frame Detail

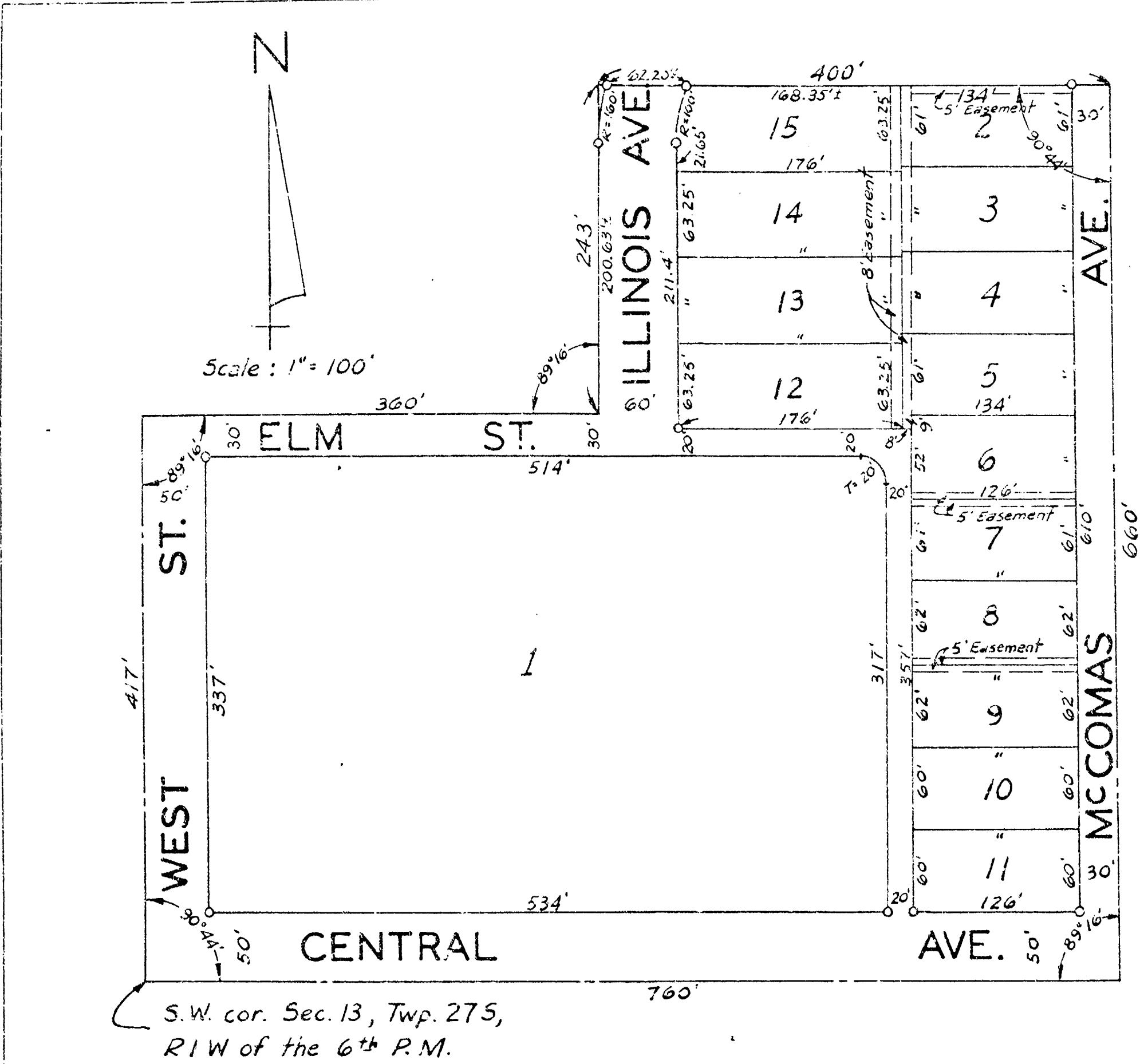
NOTE: Grates shall be imprinted on the top surface with "CITY OF WICHITA" using letters at least 1" in height. Other marking methods may be approved by the engineer.



Note: Concrete apron shall be constructed around the inlet when inlet is located in an unimproved area. Where the inlet is adjacent to pavement, the pavement thickness shall be tapered to the inlet in 15 inches as indicated on the detail.
