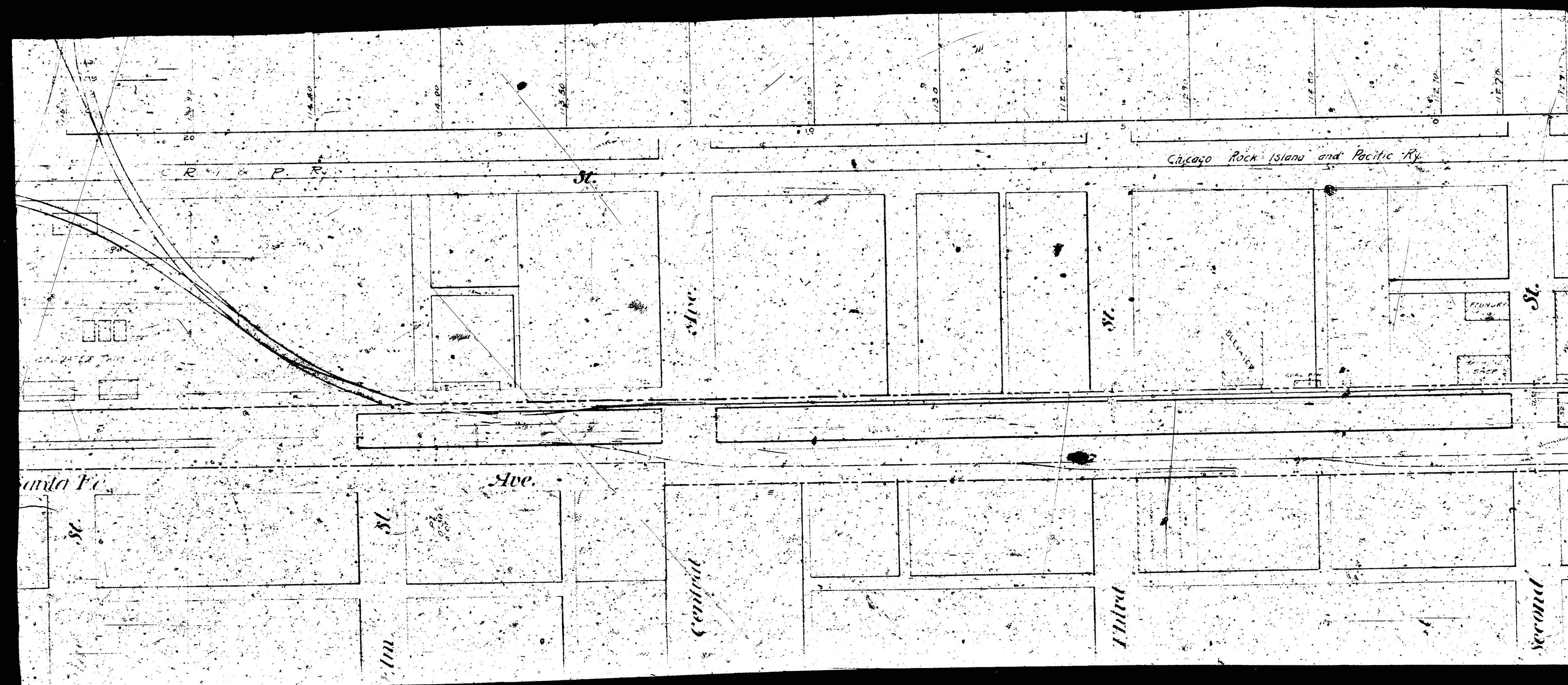
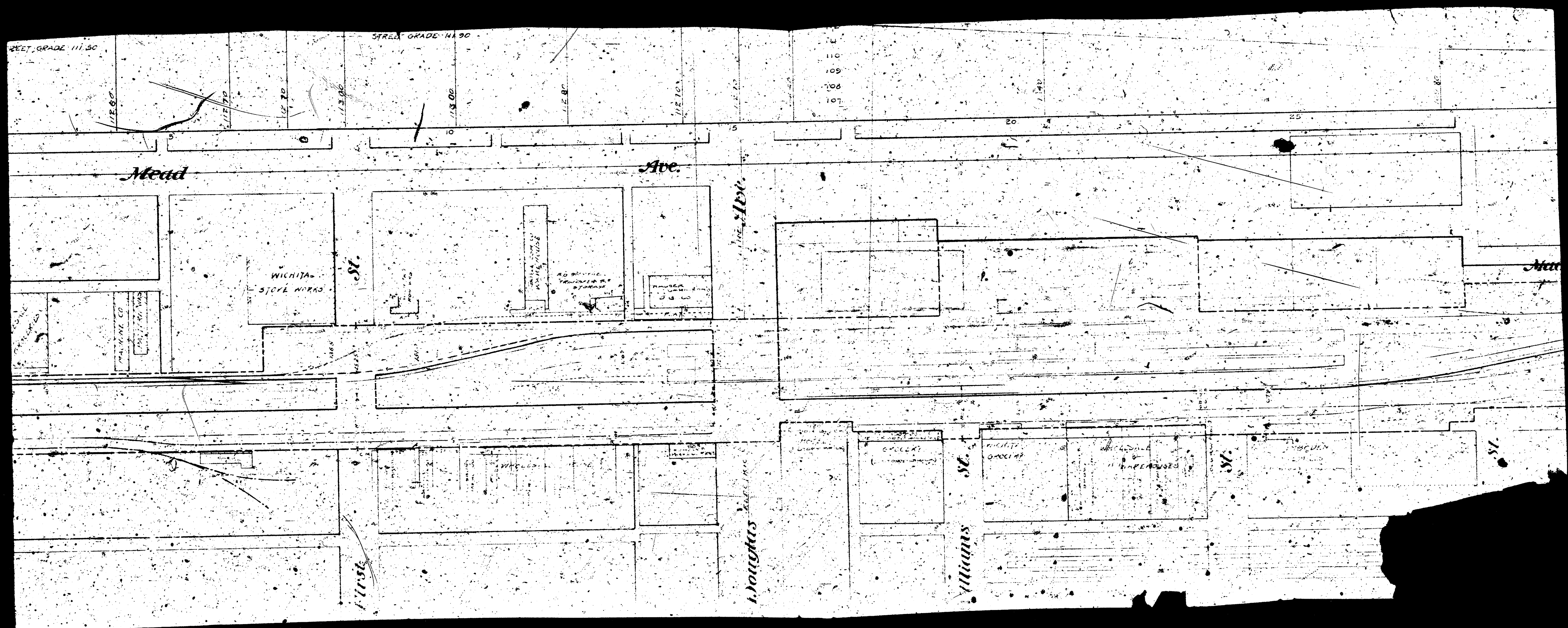






James R Mead to Wichita & South-western Railroad Company

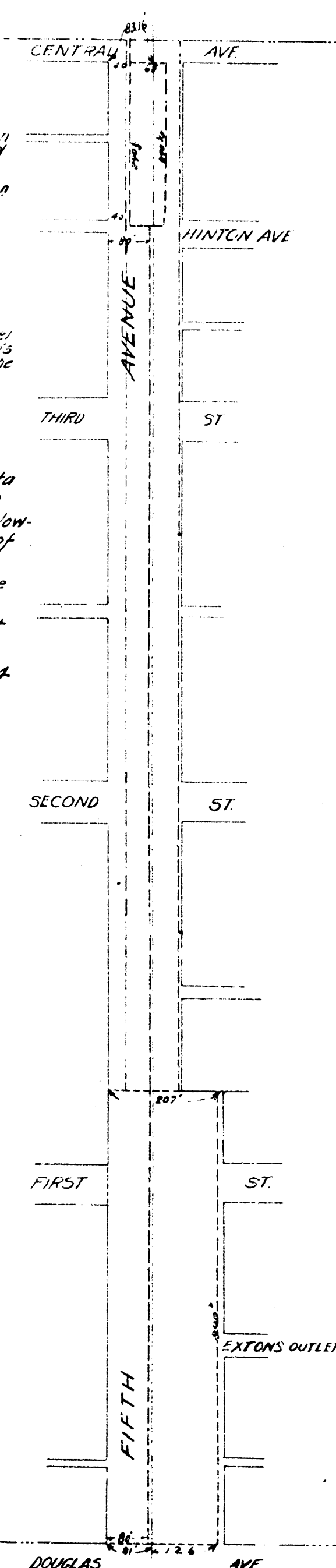

Being a strip of land 65 feet wide off the West side of the following tract of land to wit: beginning at a point on the east side of 5th Avenue, 40 feet east of the N.E. corner of lot No 47 or 170, corner of 5th and Central Avenue in J.R. Meade's addition to the City of Wichita thence South along the east side of 5th Ave. 240 1/2 feet thence east 300 feet thence North 240 1/2 feet thence west 300 feet to point of beginning.
