ORDINANCE NO. 51-605

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS OR DISTRICTS OF CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED IN THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE WICHITA-SEDGWICK COUNTY UNIFIED ZONING CODE, SECTION V-C, AS ADOPTED BY SECTION 28.04.010, AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That having received a recommendation from the Planning Commission, and proper notice having been given and hearing held as provided by law and under authority and subject to the provisions of The Wichita-Sedgwick County Unified Zoning Code, Section V-C, as adopted by Section 28.04.010, as amended, the zoning classification or districts of the lands legally described hereby are changed as follows:

Case No. ZON2021-00032

City zone change from SF-5 Single-Family Residential to GO General Office zoning lot described as:

Lot 1, West Side Free Will Baptist Church Addition, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

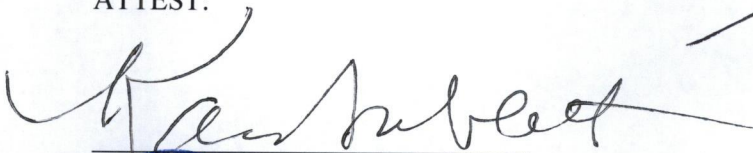
Subject to the following Protective Overlay #373 as follows:

1. The site shall restrict the uses to those permitted by-right in GO General Office, except the following use: Cemetery; Correctional Placement Residence, Limited and General; Recycling Collection Station, Private; Utility Minor; Marine Facility, Recreational; and Asphalt or Concrete Plant, Limited.

SECTION 2. That upon the taking effect of this ordinance, the above zoning changes shall be entered and shown on the "Official Zoning Map" previously adopted by reference, and said official zoning map is hereby reincorporated as a part of the Wichita-Sedgwick County Unified Zoning Code as amended.

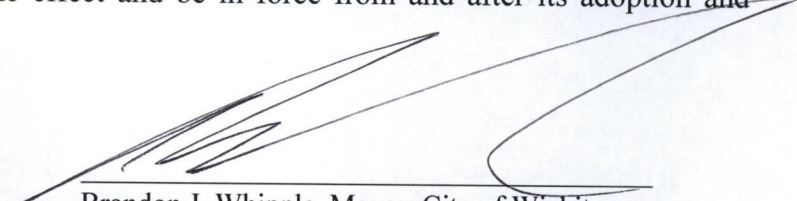
SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the official City paper.

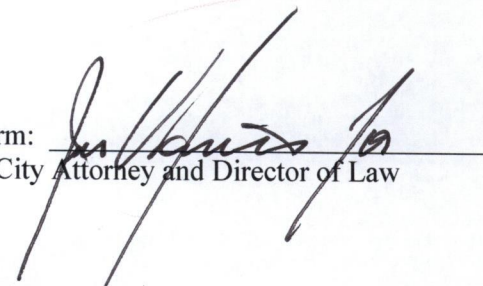
