A RESOLUTION PERMITTING EXTENSION OF A PISTOL
FIRING RANGE FOR HIGHWAY PATROL USE

ON CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY LYING WITHIN THREE MILES OF EITHER THE CITY OF WICHITA, THE CITY OF HAYSVILLE, THE CITY OF DERBY, THE CITY OF MULVANE, THE CITY OF VALLEY CENTER, OR THE CITY OF GODDARD, ALL IN SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY SECTION 11.F.1 AND SECTION 11.E OF THE ZONING RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, ON MARCH 3, 1958, AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS:

SECTION I. That after receiving a recommendation from Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Commission and after said Planning Commission has given proper notice and held a public hearing as provided by law, and under authority granted by Section 11.F.1 and Section 11.E of the Zoning Resolution, as amended, a Conditional Use Permit to allow extension of a pistol firing range for highway patrol use

is hereby approved on the lands legally described as follows:

A tract of land lying in the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 33, Township 25 South, Range 1 East described as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the east right-of-way line of the present Highway U.S. 81 and the south line of said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter, 63.5 feet east of the southwest corner of said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter, thence north along said right-of-way line 300 feet to a point 64.3 feet east of the west line of said quarter section; thence east 595 feet; thence south 300 feet to the south line of said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter, thence west 595 feet along said south line to the place of beginning, all in Sedgwick County, Kansas. Generally located on the east side of U.S. Highway 81 in an area south of 85th Street North.

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- a. The firearm range shall be utilized by authorized personnel only.
- b. A minimum 72-inch high chainlink fence shall be constructed along the perimeter of the site (firearm range area) prior to the utilization of the site for a firearm range. The fence may provide for reasonable access gates installed at the same height and of the same construction as the fence, which gates shall be kept locked except when in use.
- c. The berm or backstop shall be constructed so as to prevent the passage of stray bullets onto adjacent properties.
- d. If lighting facilities are provided, they shall be shielded to direct light away from adjacent property.

SECTION II. That upon the taking effect of this Resolution, the notation of such Conditional Use approval shall be entered and shown on the particular sectional zoning map contained in the official zoning atlas on file in the Office of the County Zoning Administrator and in the Office of the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Department.

SECTION III. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the official County paper.
