Gentlemen:

Re: Dedication from Board of Education for  
east half of Armour from center line of  
Cresthill to south line of 9th Street

At its meeting on October 15, 1957, the City Planning Commission considered the above dedication, which is more specifically described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of Cresthill Road and the center line of Armour Drive, as platted in First Addition to Woodlawn Village; thence northeasterly along the center line of Cresthill Road extended, a distance of 30 feet, thence northwesterly parallel to the center line of Armour Drive a distance of 30 feet, thence northwesterly following a curve to the right having a radius of 282.95 feet and a delta angle of 45 degrees, a distance of 222.23 feet, thence north along a tangent to this curve to the south line of 9th Street, thence west along the south line of 9th Street to the center line of Armour Drive, thence southerly along the center line of Armour Drive, as platted in said addition, to the place of beginning.

This right-of-way is adjacent to Kos Harris school and would result in a full width street.

It was moved, seconded and carried unanimously that the Planning Commission recommend to the Board of City Commissioners that the above dedication be accepted.
