Re: D-0090 - Dedication for
N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Cresthill Road from
Armour east

At the regular meeting of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission held on February 5, 1959, the above dedication for the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Cresthill Road from Armour east was considered. This dedication is more specifically described as beginning at a point on the east line of Armour Drive and the centerline of Cresthill Road as platted in the 2nd Addition to Woodlawn Village; thence northeasterly along the centerline of Cresthill Road 48 feet to the point of curvature of a curve to the right having a central angle of 40 degrees and a radius of 357.17 feet; thence along said curve a distance of 249.35 feet to the point of tangency of said curve; thence along the tangent a distance of 186 feet to the point of curvature of a curve to the left having a central angle of 45 degrees and a radius of 357.3 feet; thence along said curve a distance of 280.62 feet to the point of tangency of said curve; thence along the tangent a distance of 39 feet; thence with an angle to the left of 90 feet from the above described centerline of Cresthill Road to the east line of Armour Drive; thence southeasterly 30 feet to point of beginning. The following action was taken:

It was moved, seconded and carried unanimously that the Planning Commission recommend to the Board of City Commissioners that this dedication be approved.
