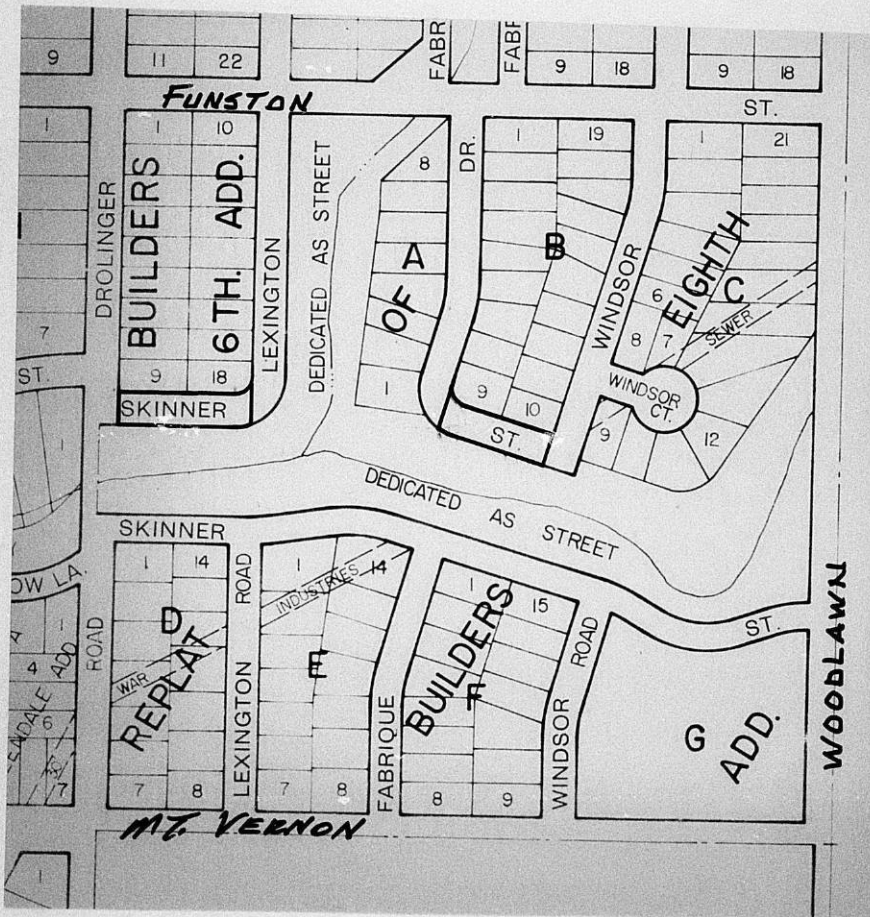

Two segments of Skinner Street  
in an area between Drollinger  
Road and Woodlawn Boulevard

Gentlemen:

At the regular meeting of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission on December 14, 1972, a request initiated by the Department of Public Works for changing of segments of Skinner Street as above-described, was considered. It was the action of the Planning Commission to recommend approval of the change as follows:

1. Skinner Street be changed to Lexington from the east line of Drollinger Road to the west line of Lexington Road, adjacent to the south side of Lots 9 and 18, as platted in Builder's Sixth Addition.
2. Skinner Street be changed to Fabrique from the east line of Fabrique Drive to the west line of Windsor Road, adjacent to the south line of Lots 9 and 10, Block B, as platted in a replat of Builder's Eighth Addition.

An ordinance making effective the City Commission's approval of the street names has been prepared in the format previously approved by the Department of Law, and two copies are attached.

It is requested that this matter be placed on the Manager's agenda for the City Commission meeting of January 2, 1973.

ORDINANCE NO. 32-478

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF SKINNER STREET IN THE CITY OF WICHITA, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF WHICH ARE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS.

SECTION I. That it is hereby declared to be in the interest and convenience of the public to eliminate confusion in the name of the following segments of Skinner Street in the City of Wichita, and the name of such segments should be, and the same are hereby changed from and after the effective date of this ordinance, and shall be known, named, and designated by the new names, as follows, to-wit:

SKINNER STREET from the east line of Drollinger Road to the west line of Lexington Road, adjacent to the south side of Lots 9 and 18, as platted in Builder's Sixth Addition, be changed to LEXINGTON.

SKINNER STREET from the east line of Fabrique Drive to the west line of Windson Road, adjacent to the south line of Lots 9 and 10, Block B, as platted in a replat of Builder's Eighth Addition, be changed to FABRIQUE.

SECTION II. That all ordinances or parts thereof which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.

Skinner Street from the east line of Drollinger Road to the west line of Lexington Road, adjacent to the south side of Lots 9 and 18, as platted in Builder's Sixth Addition.

Suggested Street Name: Lexington

Description of Street Affected:

Skinner Street from the east line of Fabrique Drive to the west line of Windsor Road, adjacent to the south line of Lots 9 and 10, Block B, as platted in a replat of Builder's Eighth Addition.

Suggested Street Name: Fabrique

Reason for the Above Street Name Changes:

At the time of platting, two short streets were platted as Skinner Street on the north side of the drainage ditch, and on the south side of the drainage ditch, a street extended from Drollinger Road to Woodlawn was platted as Skinner Street.

At the present time, Drollinger Road has not been opened to the public across the drainage ditch. Therefore, the public is unable to proceed from Skinner Street, located on the north side of the drainage ditch to Skinner Street, located on the south side without traveling a great distance.
