

SECTION I. That after hearing the recommendation of the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Commission, the name of a certain street and court should be, and the same are hereby changed from and after the effective date of this Resolution, and shall be known, named, and designated by the respective new names as follows, to-wit:

Dear Mr. Galbraith:

The Fourth Addition to Chitwood Estates has a street named Fairhaven Ave. I find that we also have a Fairhaven Drive and Fairhaven Court in Hancock Acres.

Since Hancock Acres is the newer plat and only two permits have been issued for Fairhaven Drive and Court, it would seem best to change this one.

May we suggest changing it to Haven Drive and Haven Court. I have checked with the United States Post Office to make doubly sure that this would not be another duplication, and it is not.

The two permits issued in Hancock Acres were to: Complete Homebuilders, 9217 Southeast Blvd., Mulvane for Lot 3, Block 7, Hancock Acres, addressed as 3600 Fairhaven Court; and to Melvin Hampton, 442 Spring, Haysville for Lot 7, Block 7, Hancock Acres, addressed as 3701 Fairhaven Drive.

We would appreciate prompt attention to this before more permits are issued.
