Addition

On July 21, 1983, the Subdivision Committee of the Metropolitan Area Planning Department considered the above-referenced request. The action of the Committee was to recommend the establishment of the following lake and street names:

1. Horseshoe Lake and Horseshoe Lake Drive;
2. Vic's Lake and Vic's Lake Drive;
3. Moss Lake and Moss Lake Drive;
4. North Shore Boulevard for the main north-south street through the plat from 21st to 13th;
5. Windmill Lake (formerly known as South Lake) and Pump Handle Lane.

Street names for private streets within Sedgwick County Zoo Park
(Item #7 on July 21st agenda)

A request has been received from the Sedgwick County Commission to officially designate street names for several of the private streets within the county park west of the Sedgwick County Zoo. It is felt that officially recognized street names would be an aid to emergency services personnel trying to locate someone in the park. There are several lakes within this park, most of which, according to park personnel, are generally known by name to people who frequently use them for fishing or swimming. These lake names are shown on the attached map. Only the southernmost lake is unnamed. Although sometimes referred to as South Lake, this name might be confused with the lake at Southlake Village apartments which is south of MacArthur Road and west of Seneca.

The only street within the park which is a logical extension of a public street is the main north-south one which is in direct alignment with North Shore Boulevard as platted north of 21st Street. It is recommended that this main north-south park road be designated as North Shore Boulevard. It is further recommended that the roads around the lakes be designated by the name of the lake and the suffix "Drive." Thus the names of Horse-shoe Lake Drive, Vic's Lake Drive, and Moss Lake Drive. (See attached map.)

The Committee members, especially County representatives, should be prepared to discuss these proposed private street names and suggest names for the other roads (and lake) within the park. The Committee's recommendations will be forwarded to the Board of County Commissioners for final review and adoption of a resolution establishing names for these private streets and lakes.

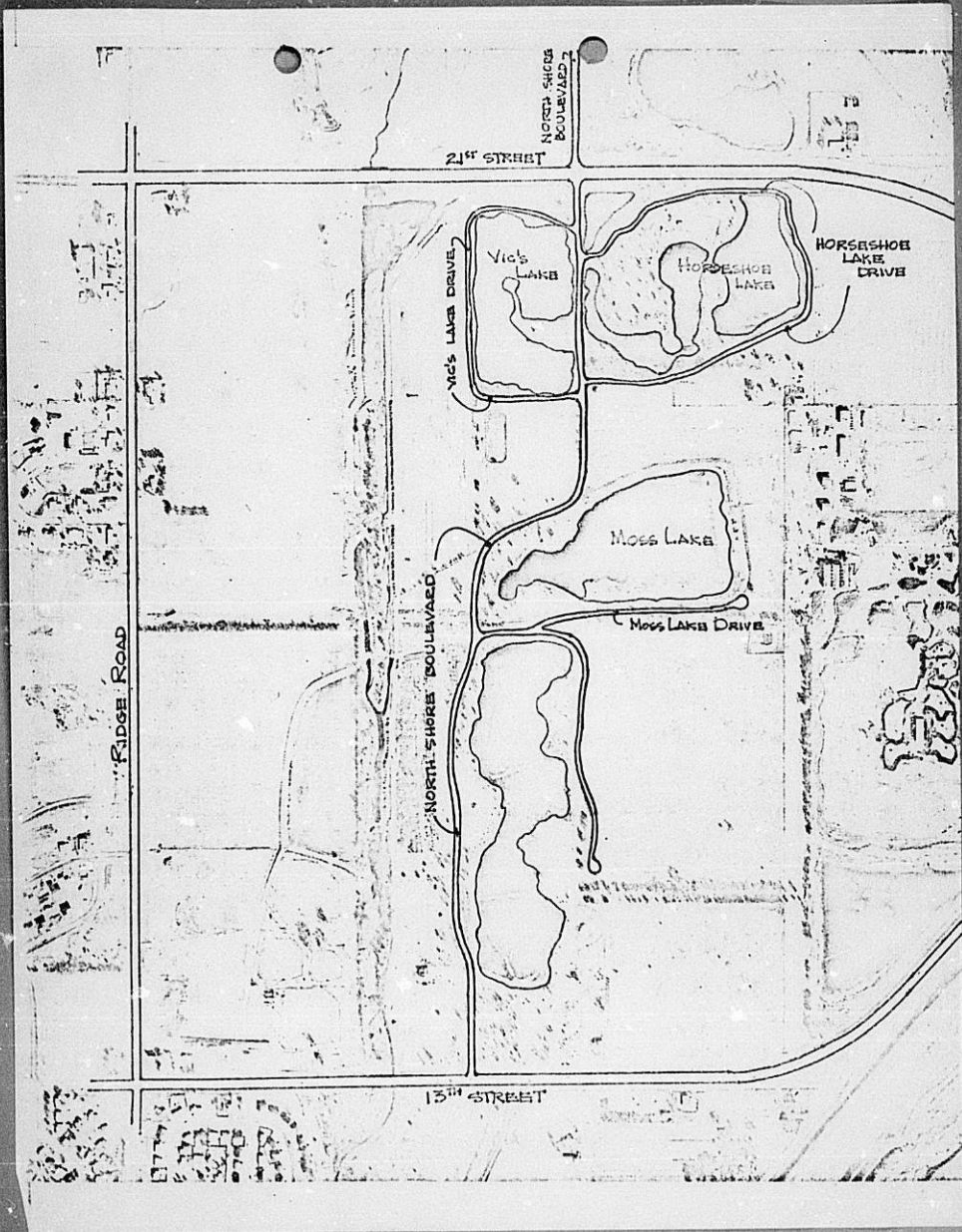
