 - Maximum Coverage = 30%
 - Reserve A
 - Gross Area = 3.89 Ac.
 - Reserve B
 - Gross Area = 5.16 Ac.
- Minimum Setback Requirements -
 - Minimum Rear Setback 0', subject to compatibility standards
 - Minimum Street Side Setback 0'
 - Minimum Interior Side Setback 0', subject to compatibility standards
 - Minimum Front Setback 20'
- Permitted Use: The following uses are permitted for all parcels within the C.U.P.: all uses permitted by-right in the G.C. Zoning District except for: Recycling Collection Stations (Public and Private), Sexually Oriented Business, and Mining or Quarrying.
- The transfer of title on all or any portion of the land included in the development does not constitute a termination of the plan or any portion thereof, but said plan shall run with the land for development and be binding upon the present landowners, their successors and assigns and their leases unless amended. However, the Planning Director, with the concurrence of the Zoning Administrator may approve minor adjustments to the conditions of this overlay, consistent with the approved development plan, without filing a formal ordinance amendment.
- Landscape and Parking Lot Screening - Shall be in accordance with the City of Wichita Code. A landscape plan indicating the location, type, and specification of plant material shall be submitted to the planning department for their review and approval prior to the issuance of any building permit(s).
- Signs - Shall be in accordance with the City of Wichita Sign Code. Billboards and off-site signs shall not be permitted.

8. Parking - Shall be in accordance with the Wichita-Sedgwick County Unified Zoning Code. A 25% Parking reduction shall be allowed for all lots within this CUP.

9. No occupancy permits shall be issued for any development without municipal water and sewer services.

10. Cross-lot circulation is to be provided for all lots.

11. All drainage ways and easements shall be determined at the time of platting.

12. Loading areas, trash receptacles, outside storage, and loading docks in the CUP shall be screened from ground level view along Greenwich and 45th Street North. Screening of all trash dumpsters outside storage, and mechanical equipment will be constructed of materials matching, and preferably connected to, the buildings they support.

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16. Any building proposed to be over 25 feet in height must obtain a Determination of No Hazard from the Federal Aviation Administration.

17. Screening - Screening shall be required in accordance with Sec. IV-B and Section III-C.2.b. of the Unified Zoning Code.

18. Sidewalks shall be required on one side of municipal streets within the CUP dedicated by the plat. A pedestrian circulation plan shall be prepared, submitted, and approved by the Planning Department prior to the issuance of buildings permits. The plan(s) shall provide connections between buildings and the public sidewalks.

SECTION II. That upon the taking effect of this Resolution, the notation of such zoning change shall be shown on the "Official Zoning District Map" on file in the office of the Planning Director of the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Department.

SECTION III. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption by the Governing Body and publication in the official county newspaper.

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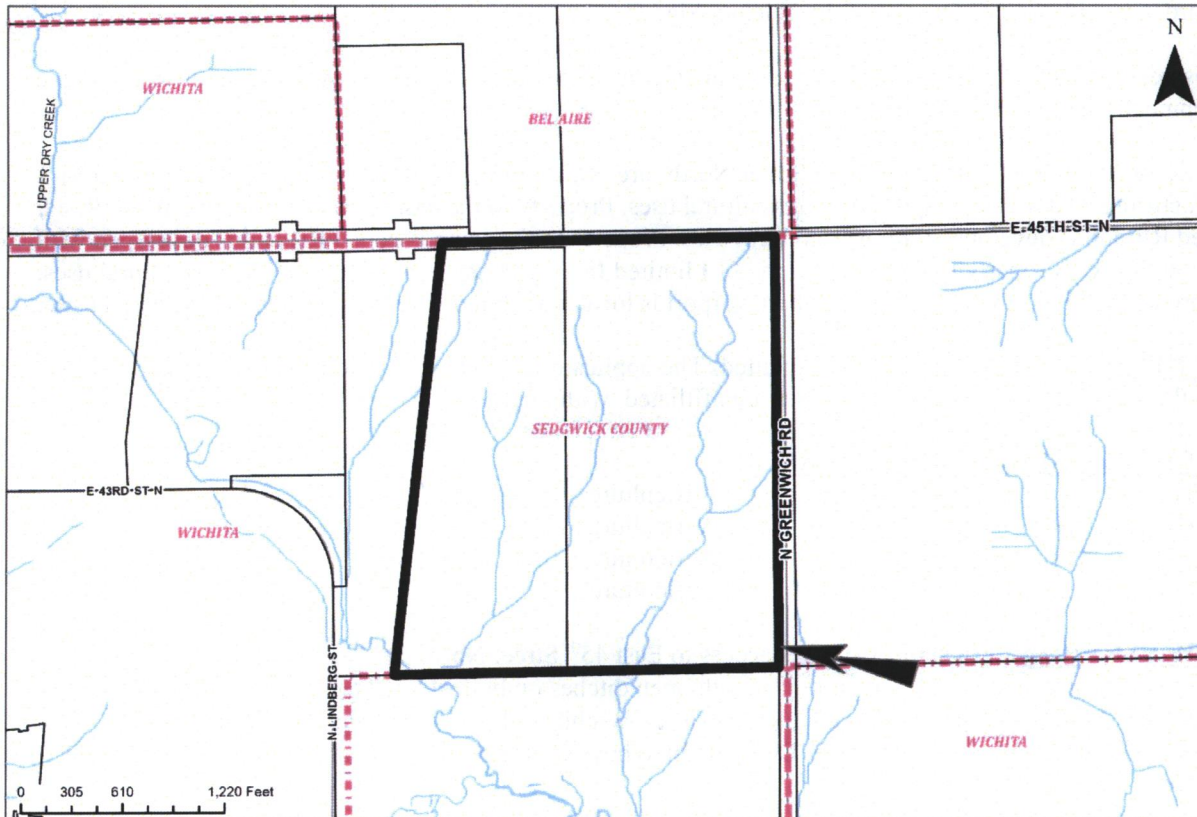

SITE SIZE: 127.61 acres
LOCATION: Generally located on the southwest corner of East 45th Street North and North Greenwich Road
PROPOSED USE: Everything in GC General Commercial District with some exceptions
RECOMMENDATION: Approval, with conditions



BACKGROUND: The applicants are requesting two items:

- 1) New Crestwood Landing Addition CUP DP-363
- 2) To rezone Parcel 1 from RR Rural Residential District (RR) to GC General Commercial District (GC).

The subject site is 127.61 acres in size, is zoned RR, and is generally located on the southwest corner of East 45th Street North and North Greenwich Road. Currently the entire site is listed as Parcel 1 in the proposed CUP with a proposed 3.89-acre "Reserve A" in the southwest corner and a proposed 5.16-acre "Reserve B" in the southeast corner. It is expected that the subject site will be platted in the near future.

The applicants are requesting the zone change from RR to GC to permit all uses allowed by-right in the GC District except Recycling Collection Station (Public and Private); Sexually Oriented Business; and Mining and Quarrying. Currently the site is developed for Agricultural uses.

The property is within Area "A" of the Airport Hazard Zone in relation to Colonel James Jabara Airport. Area "A" has a height restriction for all structures of 25 feet without an air hazard permit, which would possibly permit structures to exceed 25 feet in height. The proposal allows for maximum building heights of 80 feet. Section 28.08 Airport Hazard Zoning Code of the Wichita Municipal Code requires the applicant to obtain a Determination of No Hazard from the Federal Aviation Administration with a determination as to the effect of the proposal on the operation of air navigation facilities and the safe, efficient use of navigable airspace.

Landscaping is proposed to be in accordance with the City of Wichita Landscape Code. Parking is proposed to be in accordance with Section IV.A and Section III-C.2.b. of the Unified Zoning Code (UZC). This would require a masonry wall to be constructed at the time of development were abutting residential zoning. The proposed Development Guidelines also state that a 25 percent parking reduction would be allowed for all uses in the proposed CUP DP-363. Signage is proposed to be in accordance with the City of Wichita Sign Code. No specific zoning designation is given, therefore if the CUP is approved with this language, signage will be in accordance with the GC District of the Wichita Sign Code.

Staff is recommending the CUP text include an internal pedestrian circulation plan to promote walkable development with the CUP.

Properties to the north, across East 45th Street North, are within the City limits of Bel-Aire, are zoned M-1 Manufacturing, and are developed with Agricultural uses. Property to the east, across North Greenwich Road, is zoned RR and is developed with Agricultural uses. Property to the south is zoned RR and is developed with Agricultural uses. Property to the west is zoned LI limited Industrial and is developed with Agricultural uses. The northern portion of Colonel James Jabara Airport is located within 600 feet to the west of the subject site.

CASE HISTORY: The subject site is unplatted. The applicant has indicated platting will take place soon if the CUP is approved. No other zoning cases are affiliated with the site.

ADJACENT ZONING AND LAND USE:

SOUTH:	RR	Agriculture

PUBLIC SERVICES: The subject site has access to East 45th Street North and North Greenwich Road, both of which are county, two-lane, paved arterials with open ditches on both sides. The site is within Rural Water District #1. If the site were to be annexed into the City of Wichita in the future, the owners would need to work with the City's Public Works and Utilities Department to have City water and sanitary sewer services provided to the site.

Public Works and Utilities staff indicate that the City's 2025-2034 Capital Improvement Program does not program funding for future water and sewer mains in this area. Additionally, a private pressure booster would

likely be needed for fire flow, even after pipelines are extended. Lastly, although new pipelines would address the needs for the proposed development, the excess pipeline capacity could cause water quality problems that would need to be addressed until nearby water demand increases.

CONFORMANCE TO PLANS/POLICIES: The requested zone change is in partial conformance with the following plans:

Community Investments Plan: The proposed CUP DP-363 is in partial conformance to the *Community Investments Plan*. The *Community Investments Plan* (the Wichita-Sedgwick County Comprehensive Plan) includes the 2035 Wichita Future Growth Concept Map. The Map identifies the area in which the site is located to be appropriate for "Agricultural/Vacant." Agricultural/Vacant is defined as "Encompasses areas that are undeveloped or used for agricultural production. Agricultural land is an important natural resource. Pockets of low-density residential uses without the full range of municipal services likely will be developed in areas of the urban fringe that primarily are used for agriculture. Such development should occur in accordance with the Urban Fringe Development Standards for Wichita and Sedgwick County and should be developed in a manner that facilitates future connection to municipal services when they become available." The proposed development is not in conformance with the use categories as defined by the Future Land Use map. However, Locational Guidelines as discussed below provide greater detail for future development in this area.

Locational Guidelines: The request is in partial conformance with the Locational Guidelines. Below is a review of those that most directly relate to the request.

- Development Pattern 1.a guideline which indicates that development should occur where necessary supporting infrastructure and services exist or are planned for extension concurrently with development. The Public Works and Utilities Department staff have indicated that the City's Capital Improvement Program does not program funding for water and sewer extensions in this area and that there would likely be challenges serving this area.
- Development Pattern 1.c. states that "Major commercial and employment centers should be located at intersections of arterial streets and along highways and commercial corridors." The subject site is on the southwest corner of two arterial streets.
- Design 1.d states, "Except in mixed-use development areas, non-residential uses should provide appropriate screening and buffering from residential uses." Staff recommends that screening and buffering from residential uses be included in the CUP Development Guidelines in order to satisfy this Guideline.

RECOMMENDATION: Based upon the information available at the time the report was prepared, staff recommends the zone change from RR to GC and the creation of the Crestwood Landing Addition CUP DP-363 be **APPROVED**, subject to the following conditions:

1. The site shall be developed in substantial conformance with the development guidelines and general provisions of the approved CUP.
2. The applicant shall submit four revised copies of the CUP and one electronic copy of the revised CUP to the Metropolitan Area Planning Department within 60 days after approval of this case by the Governing Body, or the request shall be considered denied and closed.

This recommendation is based on the following findings:

1. **The zoning uses and character of the neighborhood:** Properties to the north, across East 45th Street North, are within the City limits of Bel-Aire, are zoned M-1 Manufacturing, and are developed with Agricultural uses. Property to the east, across North Greenwich Road, is zoned RR and is developed with Agricultural uses. Property to the south is zoned RR and is developed with Agricultural uses. Property to the west is zoned LI limited Industrial and is developed with Agricultural uses. The

northern portion of Colonel James Jabara Airport is located within 600 feet to the west of the subject site.

2. The suitability of the subject property for the uses to which it has been restricted: The subject site is currently zoned RR and is suitable for single-family housing, agricultural uses, some public and civic uses, and a limited variety of commercial uses in the form of rural home occupations.
3. Extent to which removal of the restrictions will detrimentally affect nearby property: It is expected that the creation of CUP DP-363 could increase traffic to the area surrounding the site. The provisions in the Community Unit Plan and staff recommended conditions should minimize and mitigate any significant potential negative impacts of the proposed uses.
4. Length of time subject property has remained vacant as zoned: The property is developed for Agricultural uses.
5. Relative gain to the public health, safety and welfare as compared to the loss in value or the hardship imposed upon the applicant: Approval of this application is not anticipated to have a significant detrimental impact to public health, safety, or welfare. Denial may be considered an economic loss for the applicant.
6. Conformance of the requested change to the adopted or recognized Comprehensive Plan and policies: The proposed application is in partial conformance to the *Community Investments Plan* as discussed in the staff report.
7. Impact of the proposed development on community facilities: Public Works and Utilities staff indicate that the City's 2025-2034 Capital Improvement Program does not program funding for future water and sewer mains in this area. Additionally, a private pressure booster would likely be needed for fire flow, even after pipelines are extended. Lastly, although new pipelines would address the needs for the proposed development, the excess pipeline capacity could cause water quality problems that would need to be addressed until nearby water demand increases.
8. Opposition or support of neighborhood residents: As of the writing of this report, there has been no public comment voiced by neighborhood residents.

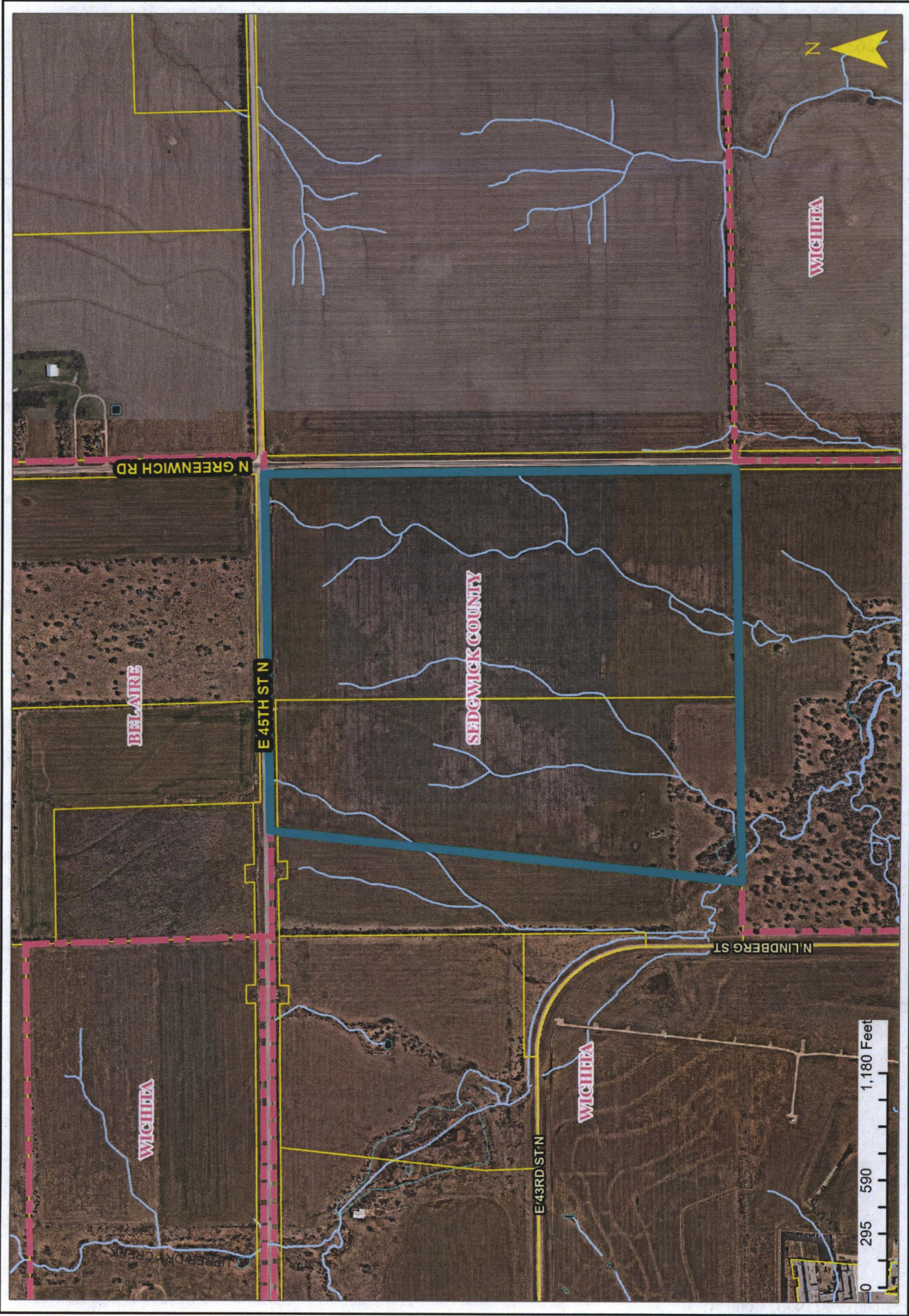

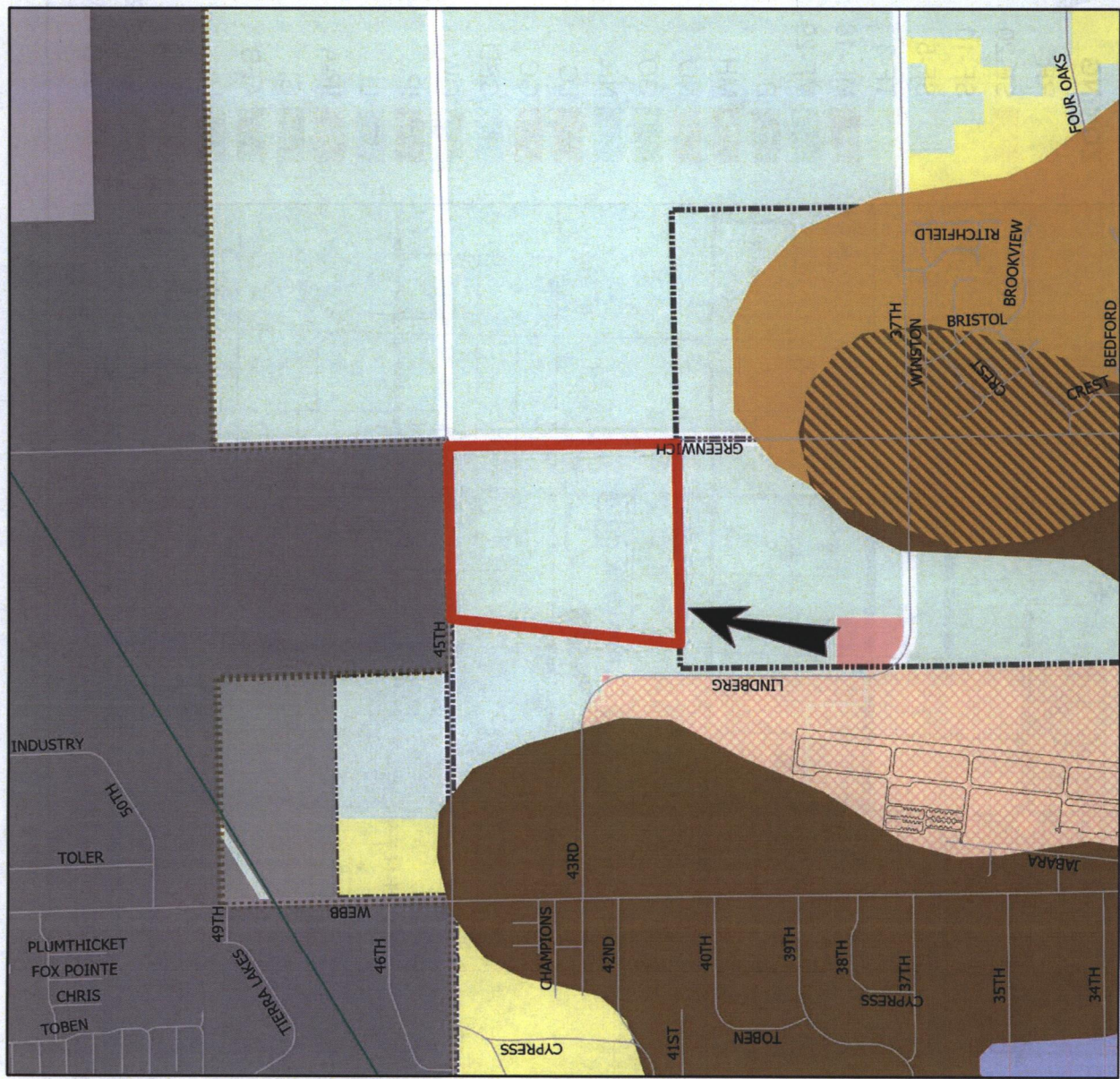
2035 Wichita Future Growth Concept Map

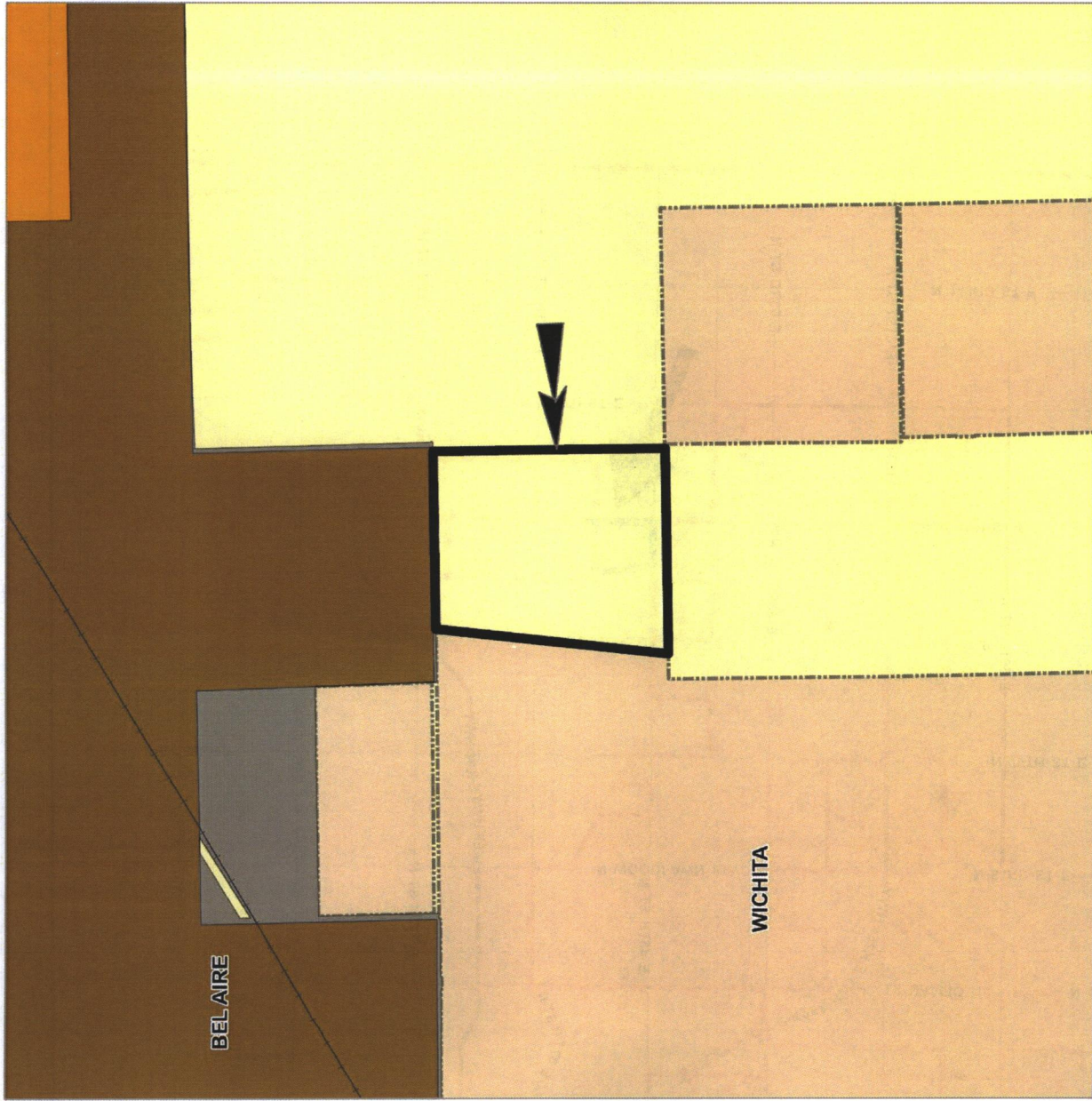
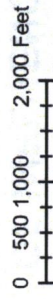
2035 Urban Growth Areas Map

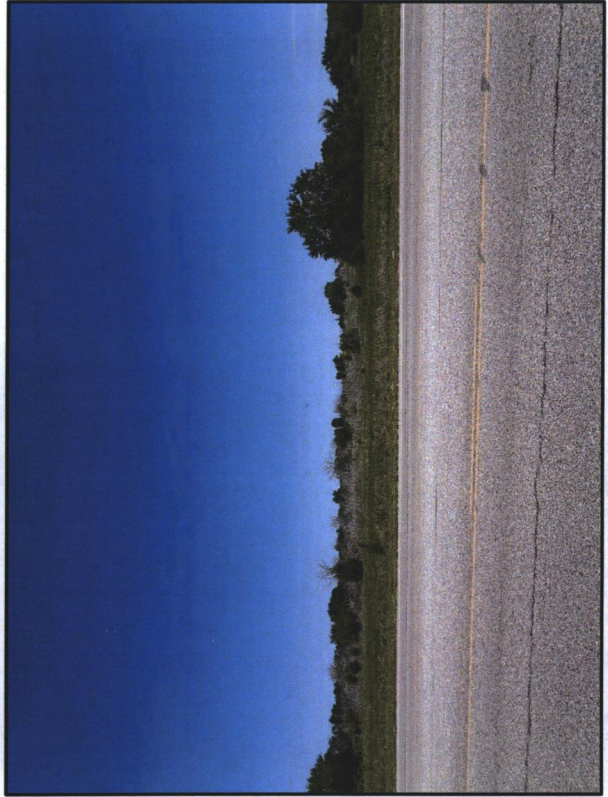

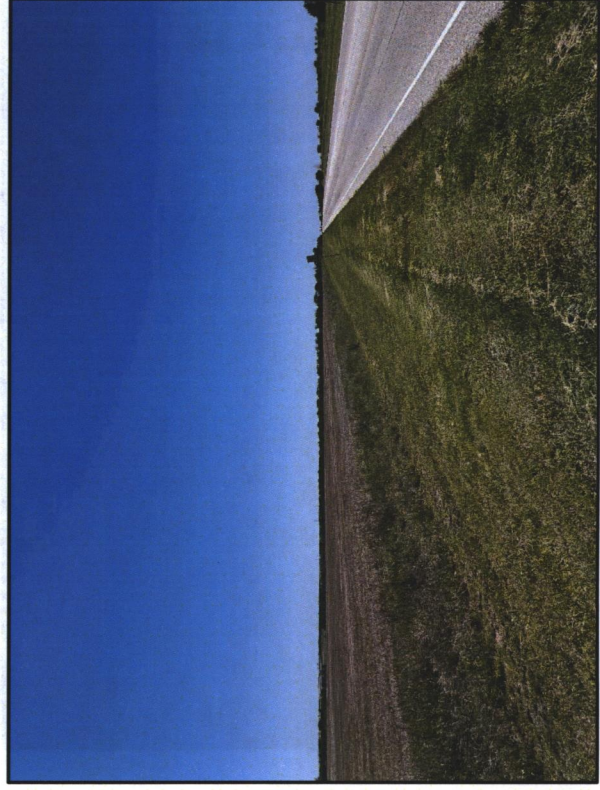

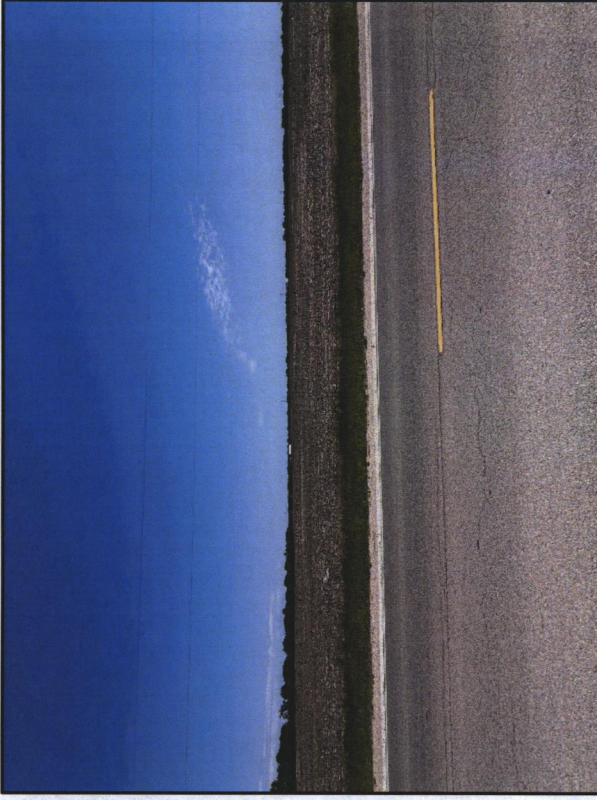

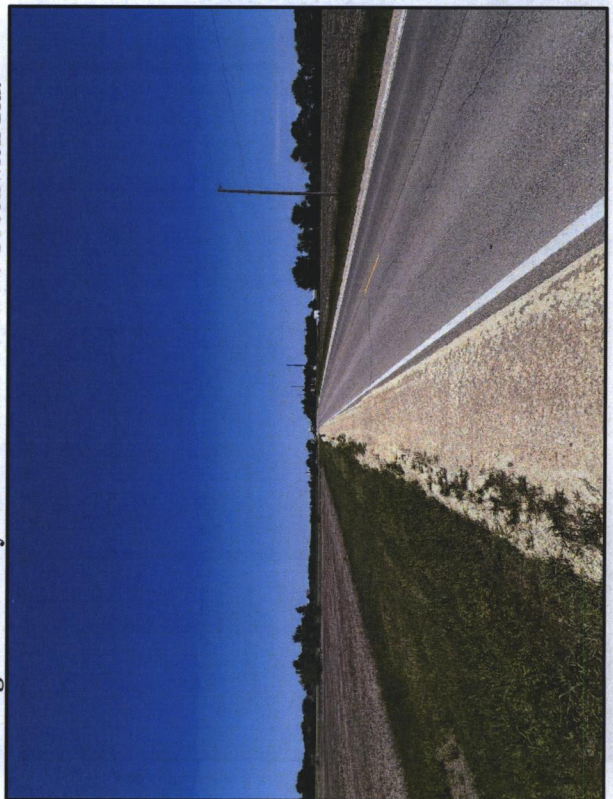
