SCZ-0535 - ZONE CHANGE FROM THE "R-1" SUBURBAN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO THE "C" COMMERCIAL DISTRICT. GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHWEST CORNERS OF NICOLE AND SOUTH BROADWAY.

Haysville 7-0 deny
The MAPC recommends that the application not be approved.

ACTION:

1. Concur with the findings of fact of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission and deny the application; or

NOTE: A recommendation of denial by the Planning Commission requires a unanimous vote of the County Commission in order to approve the application.

NOTE: 45.3% of the property owners within 1000 feet have filed valid protest petitions as provided by law. Therefore, a unanimous vote on the part of the County Commission will be required in order to approve the application.
