

RECOMMENDATION FROM METROPOLITAN AREA PLANNING COMMISSION
TO BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

REQUEST FOR ZONING

SCZ-0665 - REQUEST FOR ZONE CHANGE FROM THE "R" RURAL RESIDENTIAL
DISTRICT TO THE "R-1" SUBURBAN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT, GENERALLY
LOCATED AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF 119TH STREET WEST AND 45TH
STREET NORTH

The Maize Planning Commission recommends that the application be denied. The motion carried 4 in favor and 2 opposed.

The MAPC recommends that the application be denied. Osborne-Howes moved, Lopez seconded and the motion carried by a vote of 6 in favor (Fry, Miner, Lopez, Osborne-Howes, Polczynski, and Ross) and 3 opposed (Johnson, McKay, and Phillips). Winkler and Haggar were not present at the conclusion of this item. Goebel, Sherman, and Roberts did not attend this meeting.

1. Adopt the findings of fact of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission and deny the rezoning application; or
 2. Override the recommendations of the Maize and Metropolitan Area Planning Commissions, and approve the rezoning application, citing findings of the Planning Department staff.
 3. Take such appropriate action as the Commission deems appropriate.

(An override of the Maize Planning Commission's recommendation requires a unanimous (5-0) vote of the membership of the governing body on first reading).

RESOLUTION NO. R# 192-1994

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION FOR CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN SECTION 7.C OF THE ZONING REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, DECEMBER 12, 1984, AND SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS.

SECTION I. That after receiving a recommendation from the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Commission, and after said Planning Commission has given proper notice and held a public hearing as provided by law, and under authority granted by Section 17.C of the Zoning Regulations, the zoning district of the lands legally described below are hereby changed as follows:

Case No. SCZ-0665

Zone change request from "R" Rural Residential District to the "R-1 Suburban Residential District

The SW ¼ of Sec. 19, Township 26S, Range 1W of the 6th P.M., Sedgwick County, Kansas. Generally located north of 45th Street North and east of 119th Street West.

SECTION II. That upon the taking effect of this Resolution, the notation of such zone change shall be entered in the official zoning atlas on file in the Office of the County Zoning Administrator and in the Office of the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Department.

SECTION III. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the official county paper.

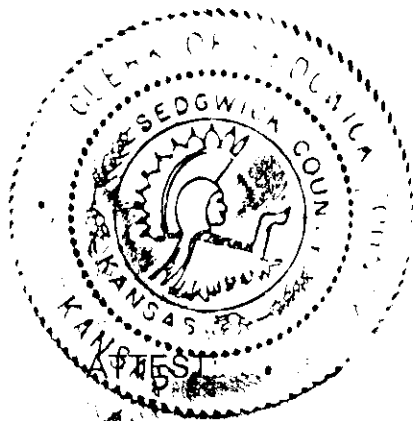
