

VACATION HEARING

RECOMMENDATION FROM MAPC TO BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS

V-1285 VACATION OF PERMANENT CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT GENERALLY
LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF SANTA FE BETWEEN 33RD STREET AND
34TH STREET NORTH

NOTE: The City Clerk will certify as to proper publication of notice of hearing and filing of written protest.

A petition for the above identified vacation request has been filed in the office of the City Clerk. The Planning Commission recommends that the Board of City Commissioners find that no private rights will be injured or endangered and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience by granting by order the vacation request subject to:

- A. Proper publication of notice of public hearing.
- B. The absence of proper written protest filed with the City Clerk
- C. All proceedings being without cost to the County, or any utility company.
- D. Any relocation or reconstruction of utilities necessitated by this vacation shall be at the sole expense of the applicant.

Bayouth moved, Goebel seconded and it carried unanimously. Moore was not yet present. (9/6/84)

ACTION: Close the public hearing, approve the vacation request, authorize the Mayor to sign the vacation order and instruct the City Clerk to file a certified copy of the order with the Sedgwick County Register of Deeds.

VACATION ORDER

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described construction easement, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. The vacation of the construction easement described herein should be approved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS, on this 16th day of October, 1984, ordered that the above-described construction easement is hereby vacated. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk shall certify a copy of this order to the Register of Deeds of Sedgwick County.
