PLATTED DRAINAGE AND UTILITY EASEMENT, LOCATED ON THE
SOUTH SIDE OF 29TH STREET NORTH, IN AN AREA WEST OF
WILDERNESS. (District #2)

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of drainage and utility easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of drainage and utility easement.
(unanimous)

Background: This vacation of easement has been requested in order to provide buildable area for construction of a masonry wall along 29th Street North. The City Engineer's Office and the Utility Advisory Committee have verified that the subject portion of easement is not needed for existing or future utilities or drainage. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing; approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order, recording costs to be billed to:

VACATION ORDER

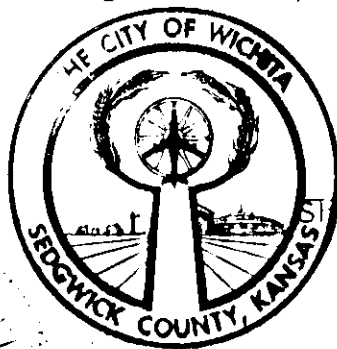

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Record of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on JUNE 8 & 15, 1988.
2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described drainage and utility easement, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s) the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. The vacation of the drainage and utility easement described herein should be approved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE CITY COUNCIL, on this 21st day of June, 1988, ordered that the above-described drainage and utility easement is hereby vacated. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk shall certify a copy of this order to the Register of Deeds of Sedgwick County.
