SUBJECT: Public Hearing V-1561 - Request to vacate a portion of a platted drainage and utility easement located south of Autumn Ridge and west of 119th Street West. (District #5)

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of drainage and utility easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of drainage and utility easement (unanimous)

Background: A garage and patio of the applicant's house has been found to encroach the easement. City Engineering and the Utility Advisory Committee have indicated that vacation of a portion of this easement and will have no adverse impacts. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

5. The vacation of the utility and drainage easement described herein should be approved.

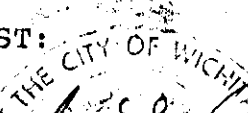
