Staff Recommendation: Approve plat. *vacation*

MAPC Recommendation: Approve plat. (unanimous)

Background: This vacation case has been requested in order to permit the applicant to finish construction of a dwelling unit which has been found to encroach the setback. After vacation, a 25-foot setback will remain. This case vacates only that portion of the 30-foot setback that is actually encroached upon. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing; approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign this Vacation order; and record certified copy of Order, recording costs to be billed to:

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

- 1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Record of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on AUG 31 1988 SEP 7 1988.
2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described building setback, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. The vacation of the building setback described herein should be approved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE CITY COUNCIL, on this 13th day of September, 1988, ordered that the above-described building setback is hereby vacated. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk shall certify a copy of this order to the Register of Deeds of Sedgwick County.



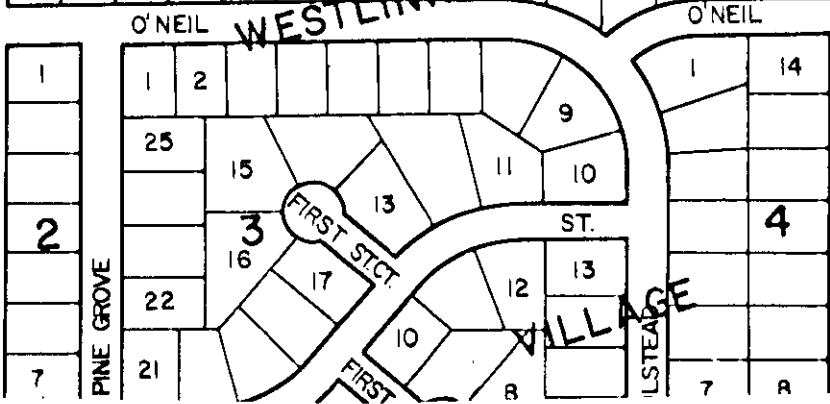
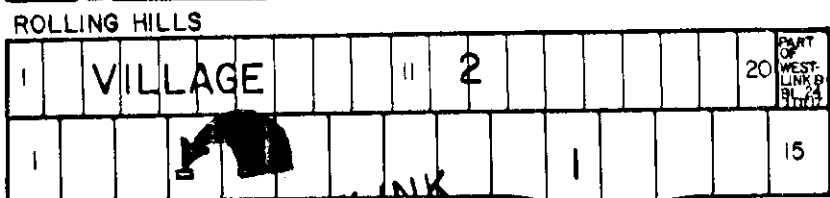
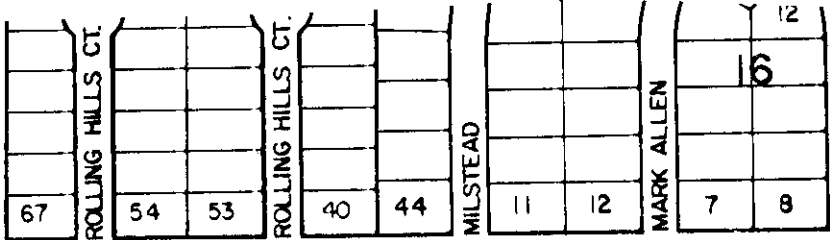
