Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of platted access control.

Background: This vacation is requested in order to provide an additional point of access for a "drive-thru" facility. The Vacation Order retains access control except for two openings to Seneca. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:




