VACATION ORDER

NOW on this 9th day of January, 1990, comes on for hearing the petition for vacation filed by B & W Development, et al., praying for the vacation of the following described platted minimum pad elevations, to-wit:

The minimum pad elevation of 168.0 for Lots 2 through 18 and Lots 39 through 48; and the minimum pad elevation of 165.0 for Lots 19 through 38; all in Block 1, Corporate Lakes, an Addition to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas. All pad elevations are expressed in City Datum.

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Record of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on JAN 3 1990 DEC 27 1989
2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described minimum pad elevations, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. The minimum pad elevations are hereby retained as follows: Lots 2 through 18 and Lots 39 through 48 shall retain a minimum pad elevation of 167.0 City Datum and Lots 19 through 38 shall retain a minimum pad elevation of 163.5 City Datum, all in Block 1, Corporate Lakes, an Addition to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas.
6. The vacation of the minimum pad elevations described herein should be approved.

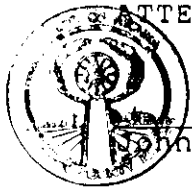
