Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of a platted utility
easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of a platted utility
easement. (unanimous)

Background: The applicant desires to construct a building over the
common lot line. The applicant has granted an additional easement to
bring an area with sanitary sewer up to standard. City Engineering
and the Utility Advisory Committee indicate that the vacation and the
additional easement are acceptable. The vacation request has been
reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to
conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper
notification and no filing of written protest.

adopt the dedication; authorize the Mayor to
