DRIVE AND DALTON.

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of a platted building setback.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of a platted building setback. (unanimous)

Background: The configuration of this lot and its location on a corner has limited the buildable area of the lot. In order to build a proposed swimming pool on this lot, the applicant is requesting the reduction of the sideyard building setback. The applicant has submitted a restrictive covenant stating that development of the vacated portion of the setback is limited to construction of an unenclosed swimming pool. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order and restrictive covenant, recording costs to be billed to:
