Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of blanket easements.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of blanket easements.

Background: In order to construct garages for existing townhouses, the applicant has requested that the utility and drainage easements platted as uses in certain Reserves be vacated. Both City Engineering and the Utility Advisory Subcommittee have indicated that no harm will be caused by such a vacation. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order, recording costs to be billed to:

5. The vacation of the blanket utility and drainage easement described herein should be approved.
