SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING V-1770 - Request to vacate portions of building setbacks located in an area west of Oliver and North of Kellogg.
(District #2)

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setbacks.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setbacks.
(unanimous)

Background: Although an existing house has occupied this site for many years, it was just recently discovered that portions of two building setbacks from the two adjacent streets were being encroached. The applicant is requesting the vacation in order to clear the title to the property. The subdivision and Utility Advisory Committee indicated that the vacation would cause no harm.

The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve the vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Vacation Order, recording costs be billed to 150029-2909.

NOW on this 30th day of June 1992, comes on for hearing the petition for vacation filed by William M. Humphrey, etux, praying for the vacation of the following described building setbacks, to-wit:

That portion of a building setback described as:
That part of Lot 1, Block 13, Lincoln Heights an addition to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas, described as commencing at the northerly most corner of said Lot 1; thence S. 44 degrees 50' W. along the northwesterly line of said Lot 1, 43.47 feet; thence S. 45 degrees 10' E., 29.79 Feet for a point of beginning; thence S. 16 degrees 31' 30" E., 5.93 feet; thence N. 44 degrees 50' E., 12.38 feet; thence S. 73 degrees 28' 03" W., 10.41 feet to the point of beginning

and

That portion of a building setback described as:
That part of Lot 1, Block 13, Lincoln Heights an addition to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas, described as commencing at the easterly most corner of said Lot 1; thence S. 60 degrees 00' W. along the northeasterly line of Said Lot 1, 53.12 feet; thence S. 30 degrees 00' W., 20.98 feet for a point of beginning; thence S. 16 degrees 31' 30" E., 13.11 feet; thence N. 60 degrees 00' W., 18.07 feet; thence N. 73 degrees 28' 03" E., 12.43 feet to the point of beginning.

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Reporter of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on 6-12-92 and 6-19-92.

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described building setbacks, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.

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

5. The vacation of the building setbacks described herein should be approved.






