Background: An expansion across property lines is being planned. A platted easement, however, encumbers the property lines. This easement is apparently not in use and is not needed. Both City Engineering and the Utility Advisory Committee have indicate that the easement may be vacated. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described utility easement, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. The vacation of the utility easement described herein should be approved.
