SUBJECT: V- 1835; Request to vacate utility easement, generally located west of Webb and south of 29th Street North. (District # 2).

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department



AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation (unanimous).

Background: This is the vacation of platted utility easements across two lots so that applicant may construct a solid privacy fence. As this site is within an approved Community Unit Plan (DP-159), applicant has been advised that all requirements and conditions for a fence as specified by DP-159 are applicable and should be reviewed. Staff and MAPC have recommended approval because the reduction in utility easement will not affect the delivery of sanitary sewer services to the site, and the vacation will not adversely affect the public interest.

This vacation has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions and recording within 30 days.

RECOMMENDATIONS/ACTIONS: Close the public hearing; approve the vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record the certified copy of the Order; recording costs to be billed to:

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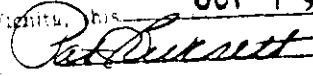
5. The vacation of the portion of utility easement described herein should be approved.

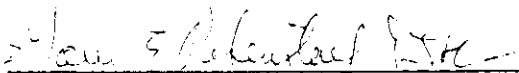

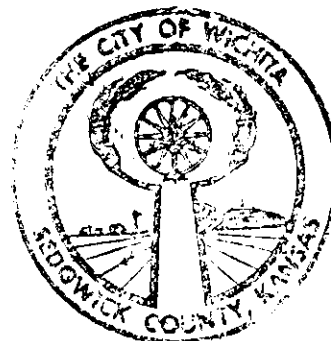

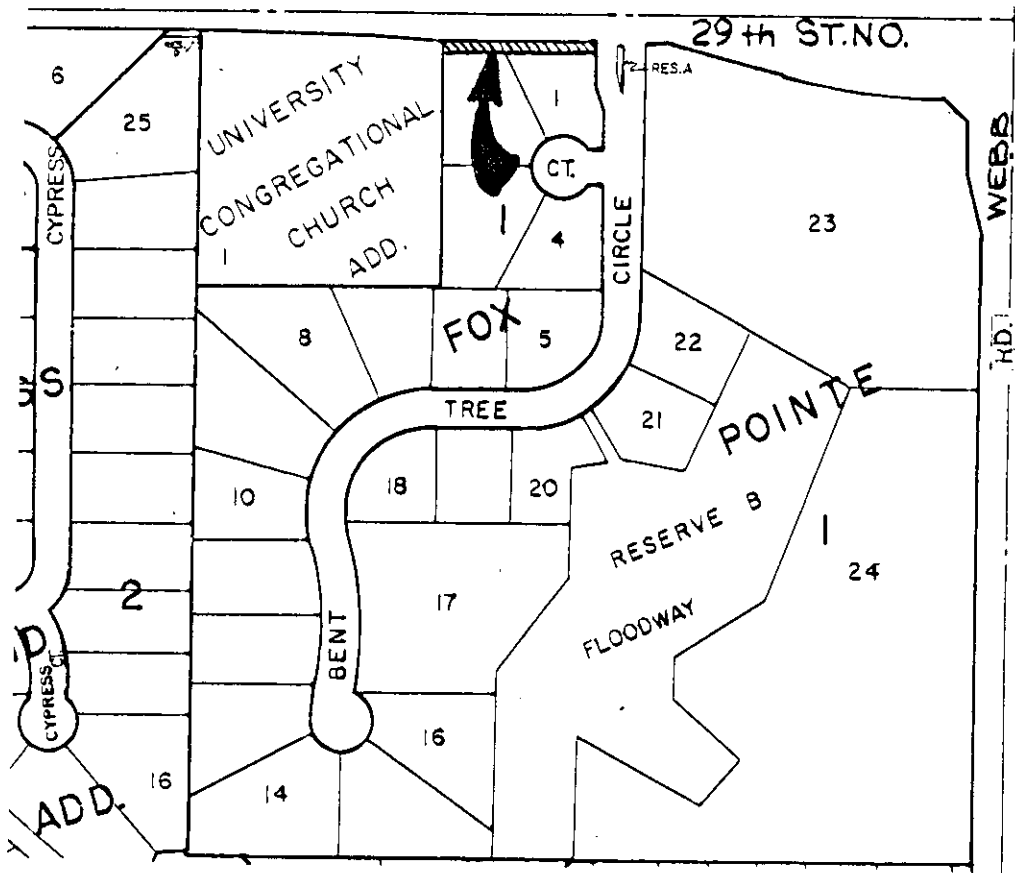
