Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.
(unanimous)

Background: The buildable area of the property is limited by being on a cul-de-sac and additional site characteristics of the building site. The portion of setback requested for vacation is needed to better orient a planned house. The Subdivision Committee indicates that no adverse effects should result from the vacation. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close the public hearing, approve the vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of the Vacation Order; recording costs to be billed to:

NOW on this 15th day of December, 1992, comes on for hearing the petition for vacation filed by Donald Cary, praying for the vacation of the following described building setback, to-wit:

A portion of the platted building setback described as: That part of Lot 6, Block 2, Autumn Ridge to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas, described as commencing at the N.W. Corner of said Lot 6; thence N 65° 10' 23" E, along the northwesterly line of said Lot 6, 25 feet; thence southeasterly, along a curve concentric with the west line of said Lot 6, and having a radius of 75 feet, a central angle of 6° 11' 03", an arc length of 8.09 feet and a chord bearing of S 21° 44' 18" E, 8.09 feet to the place of beginning; thence continuing southerly, along said curve and through a central angle of 25° 54' 30", an arc distance of 33.91 feet and having a chord bearing S 5° 41' 32" E, 33.63 feet; thence N 75° 25' 44" W, 11.65 feet; thence N 14° 34' 16" E, 31.54 feet to the place of beginning.

5. The vacation of the building setback described herein should be approved.

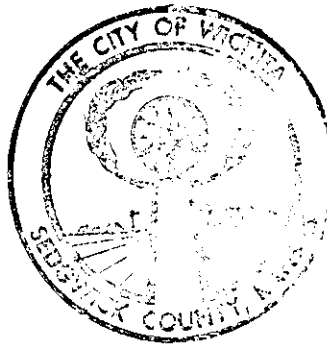
