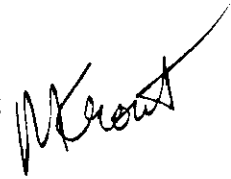

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.

Background: An addition to a home was found to be encroaching the utility easement and the vacation is being requested to clear the cloud on the property's title. Both City Engineering and the utility representatives of the Subdivision Committee have indicated that no facilities are located in the portion of easement requested for vacation and consequently the easement can be vacated without harm. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Actions: Close the public hearing; approve the vacation;
authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation order; and
