Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement. (unanimous)

Background: The applicant is requesting to vacate a 1.5 foot portion of a utility easement to allow the construction of a new home on-site. Currently there is approximately 40 foot wide utility easement on the rear portion of Lot 41, Block 2, Forest Lakes.

Public Works has approved the vacation of this building setback. This vacation request was approved by the MAPC on September 10th.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Actions: Close the public hearing, approve the vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record the certified copy of the Vacation Order.

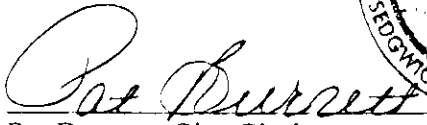

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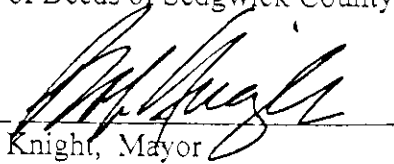
- A) Any relocation or reconstruction of any utilities made necessary by this vacation shall be the responsibility of the applicant.

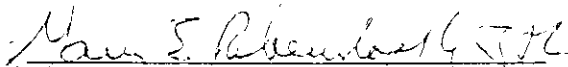

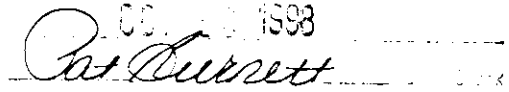
