Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement. (unanimous)

Background: The applicant is requesting the vacation of a 40 foot by 5 foot platted utility easement to allow for the construction of a larger building on-site.

Public Works and Storm Water Management has approved the vacation of this utility easement, subject to the owner dedicating a substitute easement. The MAPC approved this request on August 27th.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Actions: Close the public hearing, approve the vacation; accept the dedication; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record the certified copy of the Vacation Order.

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

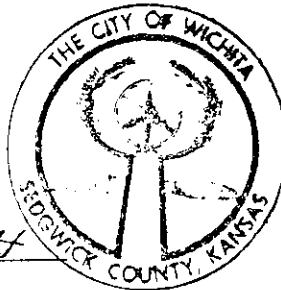
5. The vacation of the utility easement described herein should be approved, subject to the following condition:
