SUBJECT: VAC2003-00021 REQUEST TO VACATE A PLATTED UTILITY
EASEMENT GENERALLY LOCATED SOUTHWEST OF THE 21ST
STREET NORTH – ROCK ROAD INTERSECTION.
(District II)

Background: The applicant is requesting consideration for the vacation of the platted 10-foot wide utility easement as recorded between Lots 12 & 13, Block 1, Chelsea Estates Addition, which is generally located southwest of the 21st Street North – Rock Road intersection, 1941 Rutland. The Chelsea Estates Addition was recorded with the Register of Deeds August 5, 1977.

Analysis: The applicant proposes a boundary shift, attaching the north half of Lot 13 to the south side of Lot 12. The boundary shift and the vacation of the utility easement would allow the applicant more area to build a single-family home on the reconfigured site. There is no water, sewer or utility equipment in the easement. There are no plans for water, sewer or utility equipment in the easement in the future.

Financial Considerations: None

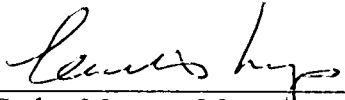
Legal Considerations: A certified copy of the Vacation Order will be recorded with the Register of Deeds

Recommendation/Actions: Follow the recommendation of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission and approve the Vacation Order, and authorize the necessary signatures.

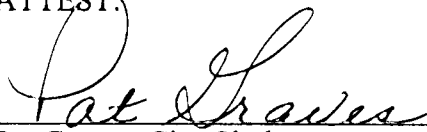

5. The vacation of the platted utility easement described herein should be approved.

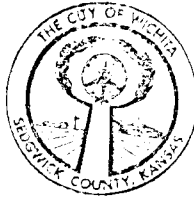

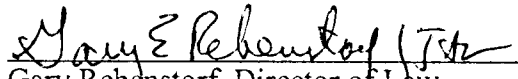
