SUBJECT: VAC2002-00036 - REQUEST TO VACATE SEWER
EASEMENT DEDICATED BY SEPARATE INSTRUMENT
LOCATED NORTHWEST OF THE WACO - 13TH STREET
NORTH INTERSECTION, 439 WEST 14TH STREET NORTH.

Staff Recommendation: Approve

MAPC Recommendation: Approve (unanimous)

Background: USD 259, as part of an expansion and improvements to North High School, proposes to build a school building on what is now a parking lot for the High School. The building will encroach over the 20-foot sewer easement located on the north 150.6-feet of Lot 1, Dillon 9th Addition. The Dillon 9th Addition was recorded with the Register of Deeds 11-18-1982 and the sewer easement was recorded with the Register of Deeds 06-06-1983. North High School is recognized as a Historic Regional Site. There are no conditions attached to this vacation request.

No one spoke in opposition to this request at the MAPC's advertised public hearing, and the MAPC voted to approve the vacation, adopting the findings of fact that are incorporated in the Vacation Order. No written protests have been filed.

Legal Considerations: A certified copy of the Vacation Order will be recorded with the Register of Deeds.

Recommendations/Actions: Follow the recommendation of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission and approve the Vacation Order, and authorize the necessary signatures.

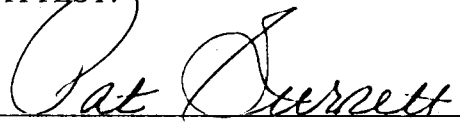
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5. The vacation of the sewer easement dedicated by separate instrument described herein should be approved.

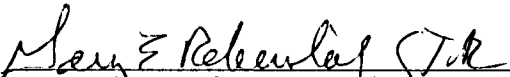
